5. Beware when we no longer share God's goodness and His Word.

6. Beware when you desire earthly things more than heavenly things.

7. Beware when you are spending more time on Facebook, YouTube, Twitter, Internet, and others as these become your priority and idol.

8. Beware when change is no longer a daily walk to better serve and to acknowledge God's goodness and love.

9. Beware when a preacher's message from God no longer encourages you to change and walk in God's righteousness and holiness.

10. Beware when the message no longer inspires you to change your old paradigm to a new one—to reach out and to serve for God's glory, honor, and praise.

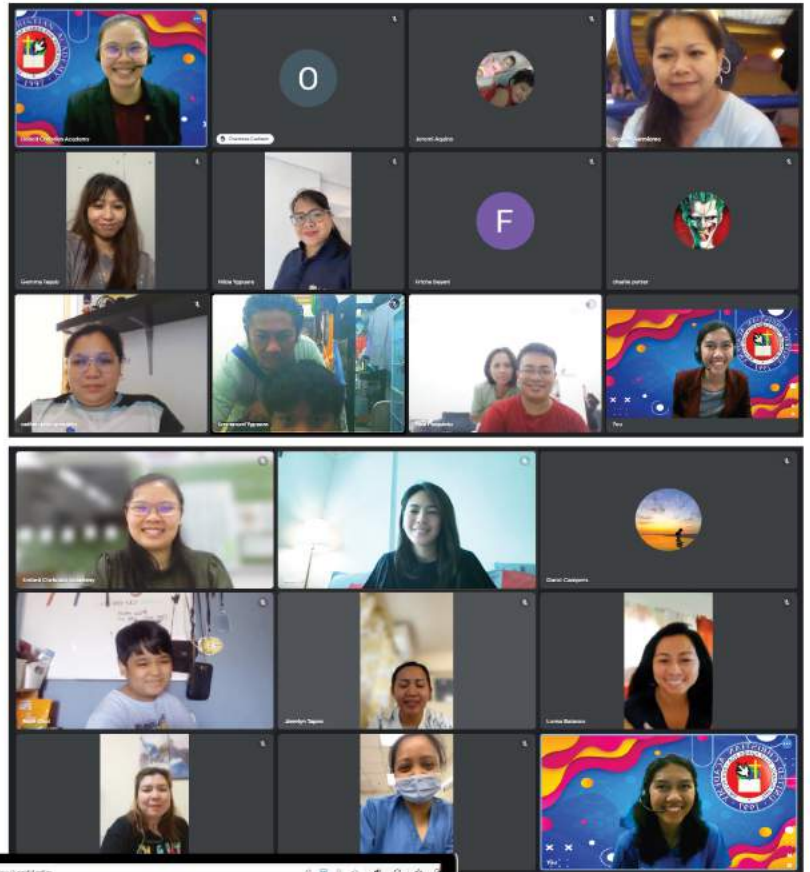
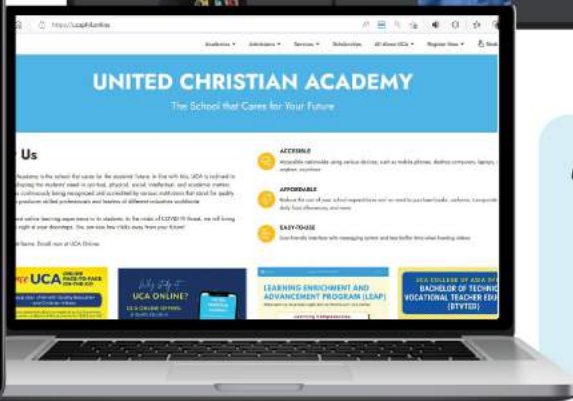
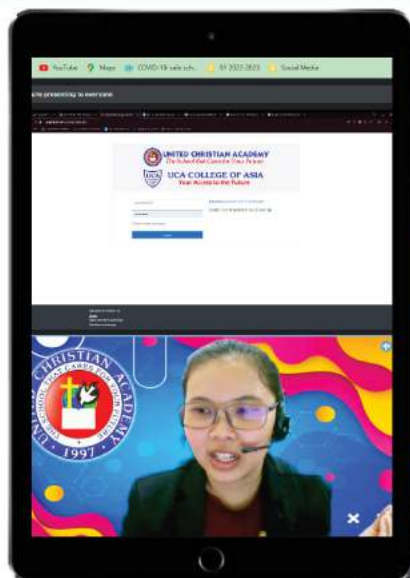
ONLINE ORIENTATION

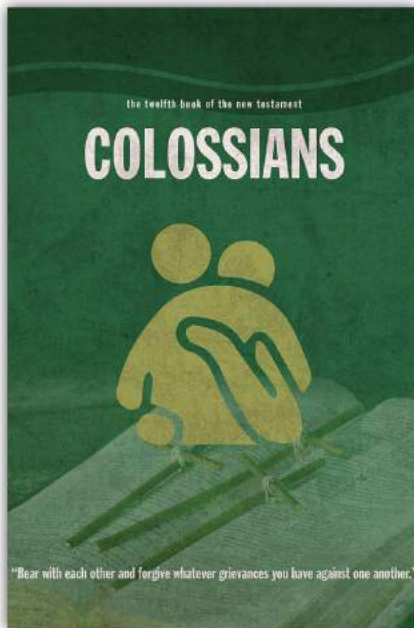

WHY READ THE BOOK OF COLOSSIANS ?

Still in prison, Paul wrote letters to the Colossians after knowing how they were facing an attack from false teachers. He revealed to them that Jesus holds the image of God. Moreover, Paul emphasized that Jesus became human in order to reconcile the people to God through His death that they may be presented to the Almighty God "holy, without blemish, and free from accusation" in the last days (Colossians 1:22).

Aside from showing the divinity, sufficiency, and supremacy of Jesus Christ, the Book of Colossians also speaks of how a Christian should be living in the world after being renewed in Christ. As it is written in Colossians 3:5-6, "Put to death, therefore, whatever belongs to your earthly nature: sexual immorality, impurity, lust, evil desires and greed, which is idolatry. Because of these, the wrath of God is coming." Paul reminded the people who accepted Jesus Christ in their lives through Colossians 3:9-10, "Do not lie to each other, since you have taken off your old self with its practices and have put on the new self, which is being renewed in knowledge in the image of its Creator."

These teachings direct His people on what to do next after being made alive in Christ. Let us all allow the peace of God to rule in our hearts and dwell in the message of Christ as members of one body called to peace.
