BELIEVER'S RESPONSIBILITIES:

Servanthood

Philippians 2:19-22 (NKJV)

¹⁹But I trust in the Lord Jesus to send Timothy to you shortly, that I also may be encouraged when I know your state. ²⁰For I have no one like-minded, who will sincerely care for your state. ²¹For all seek their own, not the things which are of Christ Jesus. ²²But you know his proven character, that as a son with his father he served with me in the gospel.

Introduction

All Christians are bought by the blood of Jesus Christ. We are all servants of our Lord Jesus Christ. Being a servant is not an option, it is a calling of all believers. If you are not a servant, you cannot rightly call yourself a Christian.

Jesus Himself became a servant and gave His life for many.

Mark 10:45

"For even the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give His life a ransom for many."

Because of our selfish nature,

we must learn to cultivate a servant's heart. If we cultivate a servant's heart and endure a servant's hardships, we will receive a servant's honor.

A. Cultivate a servant's heart

- A servant's heart is centered on the Lord's will.

Many did not realize that Paul was not making decisions based on emotions and common sense but submits himself to the Lord's will. When he said, "But I trust in the Lord Jesus...", he has clearly saying that it is the Lord who will send Timothy and not by his instructions that Timothy will be sent. When Epaphroditus got well, he said, "God had mercy on him, and not only on him but on me also." Clearly his center is on the Lord's will.

Timothy served with Paul and had been proven to sincerely care for the saints and not seeking for his own interests.

Epaphroditus focused on the things of Christ, even to push himself almost to the point of death just to

bring the gift to Paul.

- A servant's heart is willing to be sent anytime-anywhere, and to sacrifice anything just to be of service.

If anyone had other motives beside the things of Christ, they will get tired and disheartened, angry, and hurt because of the way people treat them, frustrated and weary because of the hardships, and eventually quit in disappointment.

- A servant's heart puts others ahead of himself for the sake of the gospel.

You do things out of love and not because it is your duty.

You do things for their good that mostly put yourself in a bind.

You have no problem working together harmoniously without issue.

B. Endure a servant's hardships

- Persecutions are both from within and out. Some who claimed to be serving Christ may attack you out of envy and simply because you are telling the truth.

- Circumstances strike us especially when we become complacent. Even your co-workers, who you expect to help you, will sometimes be the one to make it harder for you. - The tasks ahead are really hard for any man to accomplish. It involves a life (physically, mentally, emotionally, and financially) of dedication and sacrifices.

C. Receive a servant's honor

- God is faithful and just to reward those who suffer for Him.

2 Timothy 4:6-8

"For I am already being poured out as a drink offering, and the time of my departure is at hand. ⁷I have fought the good fight, I have finished the race, I have kept the faith. ⁸Finally, there is laid up for me the crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous Judge, will give to me on that Day, and not to me only but also to all who have loved His appearing.

Matthew 25:21

His lord said to him, 'Well done, good and faithful servant; you were faithful over a few things, I will make you ruler over many things. Enter into the joy of your lord.'

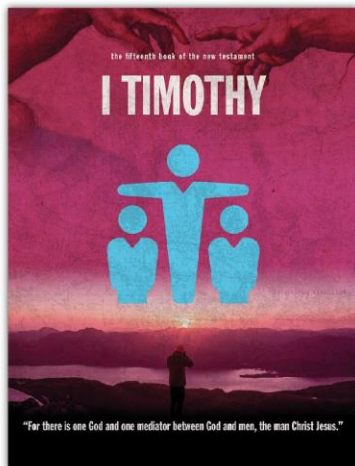

WHY READ THE BOOK OF 1 TIMOTHY?



The Book of 1 Timothy teaches about the significance of what true leadership among the young church leaders must be. Paul wrote this letter to Timothy to give his fatherly advice—a special warning about false teachers. Paul encouraged him and the young church leaders to hold on to their faith in Christ—the true leader (1:12-20). He also emphasized the importance of prayer and order in church meetings (2:8-15). As you will read the following chapters, Paul spoke again about the false teachers, telling Timothy how to recognize and respond to them (4:1-16). He gave practical advice on pastoral care to the young and old, widows, elders, and servants.

This book holds many lessons. A church leader must take note of Paul's relationship with his young disciple. Measure yourself against the qualifications that Paul gives for bishops and deacons. Therefore, we should follow the example of godly Christian leaders like Timothy, who imitated Paul's life.
