2 Corinthians 9:1-7 (NKJV)

Now concerning the ministering to the saints, it is superfluous for me to write to you; 2 for I know your willingness, about which I boast of you to the Macedonians, that Achaia was ready a year ago; and your zeal has stirred up the majority. 3Yet I have sent the brethren, lest our boasting of you should be in vain in this respect, that, as I said, you may be ready; 4lest if some Macedonians come with me and find you unprepared, we (not to mention you!) should be ashamed of this confident boasting. 5Therefore I thought it necessary to exhort the brethren to go to you ahead of time, and prepare your generous gift beforehand, which you had previously promised, that it may be ready as a matter of generosity and not as a grudging obligation. 6But this I say: He who sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and he who sows bountifully will also reap bountifully. 7So let each one give as he purposes in his heart, not grudgingly or of necessity; for God loves a cheerful giver.

Who are the givers that please God?

There are four kinds of givers that please God.

1. Believers who have the readiness and eagerness to give.

- As Christians, we will not only inherit eternal life but also the very nature of God as giver.
- Christians understand the importance of the gospel and its ministry, and their commitment to

support the ministry and to further fulfill the great commission in the last days.

2. Believers who are not caught unprepared in times of giving and supporting the ministry of the church.

- Christians understand and know their role to help meet the needs of ministry works, even to give sacrificially if needed.
- Christians are always prepared to show their love and care by way of giving.

"I have shown you in every way, by laboring like this, that you must support the weak. And remember the words of the Lord Jesus, that He said, 'It is more blessed to give than to receive."

Romans 12:13

Distributing to the needs of the saints, given to hospitality.

Galatians 6:10

Therefore, as we have opportunity, let us do good to all, especially to those who are of the household of faith.

3. Christians who please God give much and reap much.

Note: The principle of sowing and reaping is that every time a Christian practices to sow more, he can reap more for the works of ministry for God's glory.

UCA manages to keep the school organized and orderly with new signages on guidelines and safety reminders posted on every corner of the school.











Galatians 6:7

Do not be deceived, God is not mocked; for whatever a man sows, that he will also reap.

4. Christians who please God give deliberately, not grudgingly and not under compulsion.

Note

God is not pleased to accept the gift of a person if he gives out of compulsion.

- A. The giver must give as he purposes in his heart.
- The giver first thinks of the need to give.
- The giver is willing to give even to the point of sacrificial giving.
- The giver makes a deliberate decision to give exactly or even go beyond to give.

- B. The giver must not give grudgingly.
- Not as an act of sorrow (unhappy or unpleasant)
- Not with reluctance or regret

C. The believer must not give out of necessity alone.

Note

- The believer's gift is not honoring God when:
- 1. He is forced to give.
- 2. He fears what others might think.
- 3. It is just to please people.
- It is for his own personal honor and recognition.


D. The believers must give cheerfully.Only a cheerful and joyful giver pleases God.

WHY READ THE BOOK OF JAMES?



This book was written by James, the half brother of Jesus and leader of the Jerusalem council. In the opening of James' epistle, he emphasized the qualities of the believers and the importance of faith in the midst of trials.

The letter goes for the believers of Jesus Christ and not just to anyone who heard James' teaching. His letter spoke to those who already decided to follow

Christ, and by following comes the trials and testings in life. James 1:2-4 says, "2My brethren, count it all joy when you fall into various trials, 3knowing that the testing of your faith produces patience. 4But let patience have its perfect work, that you may be perfect and complete, lacking nothing." It might be hard to go through tremendous suffering, to the point of letting go of one's status as a child of God, but the Book of James tells us how it will all be worth it in the end.

The book gives encouragement to Christians to continue in their walk and also provides counsel to possible trials and testing that may come their way.
