IN TROUBLED TIMES

John 14:25-27 (NKJV)

²⁵"These things I have spoken to you while being present with you. ²⁶But the Helper, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in My name, He will teach you all things, and bring to your remembrance all things that I said to you. 27Peace I leave with you, My peace I give to you; not as the world gives do I give to you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid."

Introduction

Jesus gave a gentle rebuke to the disciples, who were troubled upon hearing the news that He was leaving them. He continued in giving encouragement and comfort just hours before His arrest and crucifixion. Rather than being focused on Himself, the Lord's focus was on equipping them for the trials that they would face. His words show us how to have His joy and peace in troubled times.

1. Rejoice that Jesus returned to the Father.

Why did Jesus tell the disciples that they should rejoice at the news of His departure?

When Jesus temporarily laid aside the glory He shared with the Father, He took on the form of a man and became obedient to death on the cross. After His resurrection, He would be restored to His former glory with the Father, seated at His right hand.

If the disciples' focus had been on loving Jesus, they would have rejoiced because Jesus was coming back to His Father and returning to His former glory. But the disciples' focus was on themselves. They were troubled because Jesus was leaving them. They worried about what would happen to them if Jesus would leave.

2. Rejoice that Jesus has sent the Helper, the Holy Spirit to us.

Jesus promised the Helper, the Holy Spirit. He will teach us and will bring to our remembrance all that Jesus said.

During the Day of Pentecost, the Holy Spirit came and baptized them, enabling them to perform miracles and to proclaim the gospel with power.

The indwelling of the Holy Spirit will teach us the meaning of the written Scriptures (Bible) and will bring that meaning to our minds at times when we need it.

1 Corinthians 2:10-12

¹⁰But God has revealed them to us through His Spirit. For the Spirit searches all things, yes, the deep things of God. "For what man knows the things of a man except the spirit of the man which is in him? Even so no one knows the things of God except the Spirit of God. 12Now we have received, not the spirit of the world, but the Spirit who is from God, that we might know the things that have been freely given to us by God.

3. Rejoice that Jesus has given

us His peace for our troubled times.

What is Jesus' peace?

The Lord makes it clear that His peace is different from the peace that comes from the world. The world has its own ways of attaining peace—peace that comes from drug prescription, religion, counseling, etc.

Jesus' peace is "shalom," which refers to the general well-being or contentedness that comes from God.

- Peace with God because Jesus bore the penalty for our sins

Romans 5:1

Therefore, having been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ.

- Peace of God is not the absence of life's troubles. Jesus Himself experienced troubles like in the tomb of Lazarus, in the Garden of Gethsemane when Judas would betray Him, and even on the cross.





Psalm 57:7


My heart is steadfast, O God, my heart is steadfast; I will sing and give praise.

Joy and peace are part of the fruit of the Spirit. Jesus had already sent the Helper, so walk in the Spirit.

WHY READ THE BOOK OF 1 Peter?



Peter wrote this letter to the Jewish Christians driven out of Jerusalem and all the believers everywhere who were suffering in following Christ. He had seen fellow Christians die and the church scatter. But Peter knew Christ, and nothing could shake his confidence in his risen Lord.

Peter explained to his readers that trials refine their faith (1:7-9). Many circumstances come in life, but they should believe in spite of hardships. Peter commanded the believers to live holy lives (1:14-16), to be honest and loving, and to become like Christ (2:1-3). In the following chapters, Peter portrayed the church as a living, spiritual house, with Christ as the foundation and the cornerstone

and each believer as a stone (2:4-8). In the same way, Apostle Paul also portrayed the church as a body, with Christ as the head and each believer as a member. Both of these emphasize a community, wherein one body part is uselesss without the others. Peter also pointed out that Christians should be above reproach (2:12-17), imitating Christ in all their social roles—masters and servants, husbands and wives, and church members and neighbors (2:18-3:17).

In the last chapter, Peter concluded by introducing Silas and by giving personal greetings from himself, possibly from the church in Rome, and from Mark (5:12-14). The Book of 1 Peter reminds us that when we suffer for doing what is right, remember that following Christ is a costly commitment. When persecuted for your faith, rejoice that you have been counted worthy to suffer for Christ.
