

The workers offer their gifts and talents to God in leading the church to honoring and magnifying the Name of our Lord.







From limited resources and manpower, God provides so the ministry of UCF will be of great success.






In 2009, the volunteers grew in number, paving way for more beneficiaries to avail free medical and dental check-up. Doctors and nurses also flood in every year to help.






