Introduction

How important is a promise?

- A promise is a covenant or declaration that one will do exactly what he says or something will happen just as pledged.
- When God makes a promise to His people, it will come to pass.

Acts 2:39 (NKJV)

For the promise is to you and to your children, and to all who are afar off, as many as the Lord our God will call.

As believers of Christ, we should understand the importance of promises.

- I. God's Promise: We can count on
- A. We can count on the promises of God because of His character.
- 1. First of all. He is not a man. He is not human. He does not have a fallen nature.
- 2. He has never sinned and never lied. He is the essence of righteousness and cannot lie.
- 3. He is the truth and only speaks the truth.

Numbers 23:19 (NKJV)

God is not a man, that He should lie. Nor a son of man, that He should repent. Has He said, and will He not do? Or has He spoken, and will He not make it good?

B. We can count on God's promises because God is unchanging.

- 1. Unlike us, God never changes in His person or His purposes.
- 2. We may change our minds as we age, as our situation changes, or as we get more information.
- 3. But God does not decide to do something, then a thousand vears later realizes it was a bad decision.

Hebrews 13:8 (NKJV)

Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today, and forever.

- C. We can count on God's promises because of His infinite wisdom.
- 1. Because of His infinite wisdom, when He makes a promise, it is the best possible promise He can make.
- 2. He will not discover later that He could have made a better promise. God never needs to make course corrections.
- 3. He does not make it up as He goes along. He knows the end from the beginning.

Titus 1:2 (NKJV)

In hope of eternal life which God,

who cannot lie, promised before time began.

Jeremiah 29:11 (NKJV)

For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, says the Lord, thoughts of peace and not of evil, to give you a future and a hope.

II. Man's Promises: How to be counted on?

A. Remember whose you are.

- As Christians, the Holy Spirit lives inside us. His power is ready to teach us to carefully consider promises before we make them.

1 Corinthians 3:16 (NKJV)

Do you not know that you are the temple of God and that the Spirit of God dwells in you?

- B. Understand that promises with responsibility come attached.
- If we break them, we will suffer the consequence of lost which is difficult trust, regain.

Numbers 30:2 (NKJV)

If a man makes a vow to the Lord, or swears an oath to bind himself by some agreement, he shall not break his word; he shall do according to all that proceeds out of his mouth.

Malachi 3:8-12 (NKJV)

s"Will a man rob God? Yet you have robbed Me! But you say, 'In what way have we robbed You?' In tithes and offerings. D. Believe in the promised power.

- People trust us to do what we say we will do. As ambassadors of Christ, it is not only our character that is at stake.
- Others form opinions about Jesus based on our actions.

2 Corinthians 5:20 (NKJV)

Now then, we are ambassadors for Christ, as though God were pleading through us: we implore you on Christ's behalf, be reconciled to God.

E. Ask the Holy Spirit for strength to fulfill carefully each promise made.


Promises are a measure of trust.
