Acts 4:8-12 (NKJV)

⁸Then Peter, filled with the Holy Spirit, said to them, "Rulers of the people and elders of Israel: ⁹If we this day are judged for a good deed done to a helpless man, by what means he has been made well,¹⁰let it be known to you all, and to all the people of Israel, that by the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, whom you crucified, whom God raised from the dead, by Him this man stands here before you whole.¹¹This is the 'stone which was rejected by you builders, which has become the chief cornerstone.'¹²Nor is there salvation in any other, for there is no other name under heaven given among men by which we must be saved."

Truth #1: Without the shedding of blood, there is no forgiveness of sins.



WHY READ THE BOOK OF *Revelations*?



The book of Revelations is the last book in the New Testament and was written by John of Patmos to the churches. Many believers tend to be intimidated with this book as it prophesies about the promised second coming of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ, without fully understanding that this book is both a warning and an encouragement for the children of God.

The first chapters provide a clear Biblical portrait of the events of the tribulation beginning from the breaking of the seven seals to the return of Jesus Christ (Revelations 4-18). John warned the believers to be watchful, hold fast, and repent because the Lord will come upon us like a thief, and we will not know what hour He will come upon us (Revelations 3:2-3). The four final chapters of the book portray Jesus Christ's triumph over the forces of evil and the eternal fiery fire that awaits the unbelievers (Revelations 19-22).

Indeed, the Lord and His Words are faithful and true, and the day will come when all these prophecies will take place. This book encourages the righteous to still be righteous, and the holy to still be holy (Revelations 22:11). At the end of the letter, the Lord declares that He is the Alpha and the Omega, the Beginning and the End, the First and the Last (Revelations 22:13), and that He will surely come (Revelations 22:20).
