I. God chose you.

Matthew 22:14

John 15:16
You did not choose Me, but I chose you and appointed you that you should go and bear fruit, and that your fruit should remain, that whatever you ask the Father in My name He may give you.

Ephesians 1:4
Just as He chose us in Him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and without blame before Him in love.

John 15:19

are not of the world, but I chose you out of the world, therefore the world hates you.

II. God saved you and called you for a purpose.

2 Timothy 1:9
Who has saved us and called us with a holy calling, not according to our works, but according to His own purpose and grace which was given to us in Christ Jesus before time began.

Romans 11:29
For the gifts and the calling of God are irrevocable.

Romans 8:28
And we know that all things work together for good to those who love God, to those who are the called according to His purpose.

 - Before: David was just a simple shepherd boy.
 - After: When David defeated Goliath, he became the Hero of Israel.



4. Your enemy will reveal God's ultimate purpose and greatness in your life.

- In times of great crisis and trial of your life, your heart may doubt and your mind may be confused, but God will show and demonstrate His power and love toward you.

5. Your enemy often forces you to use your hidden gifts stored in you.

- The reason why many gifts, talents, and abilities remain untapped is because many of us choose to live in the climate of comfort.

Note

Your enemy must be conquered, not understood alone. Do not just try to understand your adversary. Beat your enemy.

Identify who is your enemy.

1. Your enemy is anyone who weakens your dreams and passion to serve God and His ministry.
2. Your enemy is anyone who resents your progress and the growth you are pursuing. They are usually the people whom you trust.
3. Your enemy is anyone who discusses your flaws, rather than your future successes.

Keys to Overcome Your Enemy

1. Develop caution and attention.

Stay focused on your goal and objectives, and to the vision and mission God gave you.

Don't give your enemies reasons to attack you. Defeat them from the start.

2. Learn integrity and honesty.

Value your word. Guard your God-given mission carefully.

3. Consult your mentors and follow carefully.

Never attempt or expect to survive a battle without a mentor.

4. A mentor sees what you do not see.

Your mentor knows your enemy better than you do.

5. Stay focused.

Your enemy's goal is not just simply to destroy you or he would have already done so.

Challenge

Winning does not start around you. It begins in your mind.

You become what you think and what you say you are.

Philippians 4:8
