Introduction

Press on means:

- Move on, persevere, push forward
- It needs force for us to do.
- It needs focus for us to succeed.

Pressing on as a believer of Christ is not just once in a lifetime, but it is our life as we are still here on earth.

How do we press on?

1. By guarding ourselves

- Guarding ourselves is the first step.
- We guard ourselves from anything that will lessen our force and focus to press on.

How do we guard ourselves?

- By rejoicing in the Lord (v. 1)
- By heeding to the Word of God
- By avoiding false teachings (v. 2)

- By knowing our true identity in Christ (v. 3)

A. Rejoicing in the Lord

As we rejoice in the Lord, it places and keeps us in the presence of Christ.

We know that whatever trial or circumstance may come, we are overcomers and more than conquerors in Christ Jesus.

Romans 8:35-39

35Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? Shall tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword? 36As it is written: "For Your sake we are killed all day long; We are accounted as sheep for the slaughter." 37Yet in all these things we are more than conquerors through Him who loved us. 38For I am persuaded that neither death nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor powers, nor things present nor things to come, 39nor height nor depth, nor any other created thing, shall be able to separate us from the love of God which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.

When we are rejoicing in the Lord,

our focus is on His words and promises, and not on the trials and circumstances of life.

How to rejoice in the Lord?

- By dwelling in His Word (John 15:11)
- By having the right perspective (2 Corinthians 6:10)
- By accepting that trials and problems are part of our journey in the Lord (1 Peter 4:12-13)
- By putting our trust in the Lord (Psalm 5:11)
- By focusing on God alone (Habakkuk 3:17-18)

B. Heeding to the Word of God

Heed - to pay careful attention

- The Bible was written to instruct us and help us in pressing on for Christ.
- If we fail to study and do what the Bible tells us, we will fail in our trials and fall to false teachings.
- When we study and obey the Bible, only then that we show that we love God.

John 14:21

"He who has My commandments and keeps them, it is he who loves Me. And he who loves Me will be loved by My Father, and I will love him and manifest Myself to him."

John 15:10

If you keep My commandments, you will abide in My love, just as I have kept My Father's commandments and abide in His love.

- Obey what the Bible says

REV. DR. WILLIAM SY'S LIFE TESTIMONY

Ang buhay ni Punong Pastor Rev. Dr. William Sy bilang lingkod ng Diyos ay hindi naging madali, ngunit ito ay hindi naging hadlang upang siya ay magpatuloy sa tawag ng Diyos sa kaniya upang maglingkod. Iba't ibang karanasan ang humubog at nagpatibay sa kaniyang pananampalataya upang makasunod sa kalooban ng Diyos. Iba't ibang dako na rin ng bansa ang kaniyang nilakbay upang maipalaganap ang Mabuting Balita ng kaligtasan.

Taong 1982, unang naglunsad ng malawakang krusada si Rev. Dr. Sy kasama ang iba pang mga pastor at manggagawa ng Panginoon kung saan kaniyang sinimulan ang pangangaral ng Salita ng Diyos sa mga siyudad ng Kalakhang Maynila. "Mayroon kaming grupo ng mga evangelist. Kami ang nagsasalita sa mga entablado. Para makapagtipon kami ng mga tao noon, mayroon kaming eight-millimeter film na ang palabas ay mga pelikulang Kristiyano. Kapag narinig nilang may pelikula, madaming pumupunta. Ginagamit namin ang platapormang iyon para malawakan ang ebanghelismo. Tapos kapag mayroong tumanggap sa Panginoon, may mga usher na nagdadasal para sa kanila, kinukuha ang pangalan nila at pina-follow-up sila ng simbahan."

Matapos nito ay sunod-sunod na misyon na sa iba't ibang probinsya ng bansa ang sinuyod ni Rev. Dr. Sy kung saan inaabot na sila ng dalawa hanggang tatlong araw sa lugar upang makapagbahagi ng Salita ng Diyos sa bawat probinsya. Ang patuloy na pagsama ng Panginoon ang tanging naging sandigan ni Rev. Dr. Sy upang kaniyang magawa ang tungkulin bilang lingkod ng Diyos. "Karamihan sa misyon, may gumagaling kapag pinagdarasal at iku-kuwento na sa iba na pinagaling sila ng Diyos. Doon na magsisimulang magtipon ang mga tao. Doon na rin madalas nagsisimula ang ministry."

the Bible







The Growing Believers

Despite all the things that we have faced—the situations, difficulties, hunger, and many problems—we are still here because of the grace of our God. Kaya maganda na lagi natin itong sinasariwa sa ating mga buhay. Growth is not limited to money and physical things. Mayroon tayong hindi nakikita na kailangan natin upang tayo ay lumago.

Halimbawa ay ang emosyon natin. Dapat ang ating emosyon ay lumalago rin. Dati kapag may nang-inis sa iyo, ikaw ay bibigay na kaagad. Kailangan din ng ating emosyon ang paglago. Kailangan natin itong kontrolin. May pagkakataon sa bawat pamilya natin na hindi nagkakaintindihan. Nagkakaroon ng pag-iinit, pagtatalo at hindi pagkakaunawaan. But then again, that is not important. Ang importante doon ay nagkaroon man tayo ng ganoon sa ating pamilya, darating tayo sa punto na sasabihin nating nagkamali tayo. Pagkatapos noon, hihingi ka ng pasensya tao. Dapat umaamin din tayo. Importante ito sa ating paglago. Doon natin makikita kung tayo ay lumalago sa ating pag-iisip, buhay pag-aaral, buhay pagtatrabaho, buhay pagnenegosyo, buhay pagpapamilya at buhay pag-aasawa. Lahat ng ito ay parte ng paglago. Sa 1 Tesalonica 1:2-10, makikita natin ang isang simbahang kausap ni Apostol Pablo.

This specific church, the church in Thessalonica, had young believers. Sila ang mga bago palang na naniniwala, mga bagong mananampalataya na kakatanggap pa lang kay Hesu Kristo. At mayroong malaking nangyari sa kanila na dapat matutunan ng bawat mananampalataya.

JAMES 2 SAYS, "FAITH WITHOUT WORKS IS DEAD." WE SHOULD HAVE A WORKING FAITH.

Paul and his companions were faithful to bring the Gospel to the Thessalonians in the midst of persecution. Even though Paul, Timothy, and Silas were being persecuted, they still brought the Good News to the people so that they might know Jesus Christ. Paul and his companions stood above all the persecution that they faced. It is because of them that the Thessalonians believed in God. The Thessalonians had only recently become Christians, and yet they remained faithful to the Lord despite the fact that the apostles were not with them. Nakasama lang kasi ng mga taga-Tesalonica sina Paul at ang mga kasama niya sa maikling panahon lamang. Ngunit ito ang punto-kahit kaunting oras lang sila nagkasama, ang mga taga-Tesalonica ay nakakilala sa Panginoon at sila ngayon ay lumago. They were just young believers. Although some of them were not young anymore, but they were growing. Importante kasi ito sa isang mananampalataya-ang paglago.

According to this passage, we can learn the key characteristics of the growing believers in the Thessalonian church. They turn to God at all times. They remember Him without ceasing the work of faith. Ang pananampalataya ay mayroong paggawa. Because James 2:26 says, "Faith without works is dead." We should have a working faith. WORSHIP

In the Old Testament, the people of God in Israel were commanded to worship and serve the Lord their God. In this commandment from Exodus 24:1, it says "Now He said to Moses, 'Come up to the Lord, you and Aaron, Nadab and Abihu, and seventy of the elders of Israel, and worship from afar." The Word of God commanded the Israelites to worship Him from a distance, which means they can only worship God when they gather around the sacred mountain and consecrate themselves first. In history, God established this barrier between humans-including the Tabernacle where God's Holy Ark of Covenant was placed. The Tabernacle was a visual reminder of the separation between God and His sinful people. Because of sin, people weren't able to freely come into His presence and worship Him whenever or wherever they want.

However, the New Testament tells us that Jesus already fulfilled the sin offerings through His death (Hebrews 9:11-14). In Romans 12:1, it states "I urge you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, to present your bodies a living and holy sacrifice, well-pleasing to God, which is your spiritual service of worship." This clearly says that by the mercies of God, which intended Christ's death on the cross, the sin of the people may be forgiven. As His children, we are not to offer again various prescribed offerings to be allowed to enter God's presence, but once we offer our lives to God, it is a personal sacrifice and becomes a spiritual service of worship to Him.




