HOW TO WALK AS *Children of God?*

Ephesians 5:15-21 (NASB)

¹⁵So then, be careful how you walk, not as unwise people but as wise, ¹⁶making the most of your time, because the days are evil. ¹⁷Therefore do not be foolish, but understand what the will of the Lord is. ¹⁸And do not get drunk with wine, in which there is debauchery, but be filled with the Spirit, ¹⁹speaking to one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody with your hearts to the Lord; ²⁰always giving thanks for all things in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ to our God and Father; ²¹and subject yourselves to one another in the fear of Christ.

Introduction

God had already revealed His eternal plan and purpose for His church/children. Life is a walk, a path that we tread every day. God expects us to walk carefully and accurately. As His church/children, how should we conduct ourselves in a manner worthy of our calling?

A. Our Attitude (Be careful how you walk.)

- Not as unwise people but as wise

The unwise – a person who is careless and worldly-minded. Making mistakes is just the way of all human life—not concerned about giving into temptations. He thinks that he will be acceptable to God no matter what.

The wise – thoughtful and spiritually-minded. Mistakes matter to him. He struggles to make sure to follow God completely.

Proverbs 1:7 (NKJV)

The fear of the Lord is the beginning of knowledge, But fools despise wisdom and instruction.

Proverbs 8:13 (NKJV)

The fear of the Lord is to hate evil; Pride and arrogance and the evil way And the perverse mouth I hate.

Proverbs 9:10 (NKJV)

"The fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom, And the knowledge of the Holy One is understanding."

- Making the most of your time

Time is a gift that cannot be undone. The idea is not to buy time or to make time but to use time for things with value. Use your time to take advantage of the opportunities to serve God. (Time is short.)

Opportunities: To witness, to show diligence, to love, to minister, to pray, to give, etc.

1 Corinthians 7:29-31 (NKJV)

²⁹But this I say, brethren, the time is short, so that from now on even those who have wives should be as though they had none, ³⁰those who weep as though they did not weep, those who rejoice as though they did not rejoice, those who buy as though they did not possess, ³¹and those who use this world as not misusing it. For the form of this world is passing away.

Colossians 4:5-6 (NKJV)

⁵Walk in wisdom toward those who are outside, redeeming the time. ⁶Let your speech always be with grace, seasoned with salt, that you may know how you ought to answer each one.

B. Our Values (Do not be foolish, but understand what the will of the Lord is.)

The wise understands (perceive, comprehend) God's will. It is the believer's only weapon to defeat the "evil days".

- Know God's Word by heart

- Sensitive to the Holy Spirit

Psalm 143:10 (NKJV)

Teach me to do Your will, For You are my God; Your Spirit is good. Lead me in the land of uprightness.

John 16:13 (NKJV)

However, when He, the Spirit of truth, has come, He will guide you into all truth; for He will not speak on His own authority, but whatever He hears He will speak; and He will tell you things to come.

REV. DR. WILLIAM SY'S LIFE TESTIMONY

PAGSAKATUPARAN NG PANGITAIN

Bahagi ng pangitaing ibinigay ng Panginoon sa ating Punong Pastor na si Rev. Dr. William Sy ay ang pagtatag ng UCF Group of Ministries na magiging daan upang matupad ang kabuuang pangitain ng panambahan para sa kaluwalhatian ng Panginoon.

Taong 2010 nang ipakita ng Panginoon kay Rev. Dr. Sy ang isang pangitain patungkol sa UCF Group of Ministries sa pamamagitan ng inspirasyon na nanggaling sa Panginoon. Ang UCF Group of Ministries ay mayroong tungkulin na maisakatuparan ang kabuuang pangitain at tawag ng Diyos sa ating panambahan—ang magtayo ng mga ministeryong maghahayag ng Salita ng Diyos at aakay sa mga nawawalang kaluluwa sa Kaharian ng Diyos.

Bilang kabuuhan, ang UCF ay binubuo ng sampung mga ministryo kung saan pito sa mga ito ay kasalukuyang naitatag na at nagagamit bilang daan para maabot ang mga naghahanap sa Panginoon. Sa nakalipas na 36 na taon ay naitatag at mas napaunlad ng Diyos ang ilan sa UCF Group of Ministries. Isa na rito ang United Christian Academy (UCA) na nagsisilbing pintuan para sa mga kabataang tinawag din ng Diyos sa Kaniyang kaharian.

Noong 1992, isang pangitain ang ipinagkaloob ng Panginoon kay Rev. Dr. Sy kung saan makukulay na salamin mula sa iba't ibang direksyon na tila'y naghugis libro na mayroong iba't ibang kulay at anyo ang kaniyang nakita. Dahil dito, buong akala ni Rev. Dr. Sy na isang Bible school ang ipinapatayo sa kanya ng Panginoon. Taong 1993 noong magsimula ang unang batch ng Bible Training School na may hangaring humubog ng mga manggagawa para sa ubasan ng Diyos.

Matapos ang dalawang taon, panandalian itong natigil dahil muling nangusap ang Panginoon kay Rev. Dr. Sy at mas malinaw na mensahe ang hatid ng Diyos—ang magtayo ng isang academic school, ang UCA. Kaya naman agad na sinimulan ni Rev. Dr. Sy na itayo ang UCA sa kaniyang munting tahanan kasama ang ilang mga guro noong 1997. Nagsimula mansa malit, ngunit dahil sa pananampalataya at pagsunod ni Rev. Dr. Sy sa kalooban ng Panginoon, unti-unti itong lumago. Kasabay ng pagdami ng mga mag-aaral ng paaralan ay ang pagdami ng kabataang nakakilala at nakasumpong sa Panginoon. Mas ipinamalas pa ng Panginoon ang Kaniyang katapatan sa Kaniyang ministryo sa taong 2018 noong umabot sa higit isang libo ang mga mag-aaral ng UCA.

Taong 2008 naman nang muling binuksan ang UCF Bible Training Center at ito ay pinanganlangang UCF Theological Seminary sa pangunguna ni Rev. Dr. Sy. Nagpatuloy ang UCFTS sa pagsasanay ng mga manggagawa ng panambahan buong pusong nagdesisyon na sumunod sa plano ng Panginoon sa kanilang buhay. Dahil sa pagpapagal ni Rev. Dr. Sy, ilang mga manggagawa na ang ginagamit ng Diyos sa Kaniyang ubasan.





WHY READ THE BOOK OF LUKE?



Book of Luke is written by one of Jesus' disciples, Luke. His narrative contains the birth of Christ up to His death. This book includes several accounts of the nature of Jesus, His ministry of healing, His teachings and sermons through parables, His death, and even His resurrection.

Through Jesus' ministry, He showed that He came to seek and save the lost. One of the significant encounters in this book is when Jesus defends Zacchaeus who already repented

but was continuously dismissed by the Pharisees and the scribes (Luke 15:1-32). Jesus defends him by saying, "Just so, I tell you, there will be more joy in heaven over one sinner who repents than over ninety-nine righteous persons who need no repentance." It can be read in the book repeatedly that God's kingdom exalts the humble and brings down the proud (Luke 1:51-53; 14:7-14; 18:9-14). Truly, salvation is not by our own works but by the grace of God and through the faith that we have in Christ Jesus (Ephesians 2:8).

C. Our Acts

1 Corinthians 6:9-10 (NKJV)

"Do you not know that the unrighteous will not inherit the kingdom of God? Do not be deceived. Neither fornicators, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor homosexuals, nor sodomites, ¹⁰nor thieves, nor covetous, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor extortioners will inherit the kingdom of God.

- Do not get drunk with wine, but be filled with the Spirit (when in private).

2 Timothy 1:7 (NKJV)

For God has not given us a spirit of fear, but of power and of love and of a sound mind.

- Speaking to one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs (when in gatherings)
- Always giving thanks for all things in the Name of our Lord Jesus Christ to our God and Father (when in public)

Singing praises is both vertical and horizontal.

1 Corinthians 14:15-17 (NKJV)

¹⁵What is the conclusion then? I will pray with the spirit, and I will also pray with the understanding. I will sing with the spirit, and I will also sing with the understanding.

¹⁶Otherwise, if you bless with the spirit, how will he who occupies the place of the uninformed say

"Amen" at your giving of thanks, since he does not understand what you say? ¹⁷For you indeed give thanks well, but the other is not edified.

- Subject yourselves to one another in the fear of Christ.

Philippians 2:1-4 (NKJV)

"Therefore if there is any consolation in Christ, if any comfort of love, if any fellowship of the Spirit, if any affection and mercy, ²fulfill my joy by being like-minded, having the same love, being of one accord, of one mind. ³Let nothing be done through selfish ambition or conceit, but in lowliness of mind let each esteem others better than himself. ⁴Let each of you look out not only for his own interests, but also for the interests of others.

Challenge

We are to constantly be filled with the Spirit. We are to be conscious of His presence, His leading. We need to choose to walk obediently to Christ. The Lord's presence are given to believers who receive the commandment of Christ and keep them.

John 14:21 (NKJV)

He who has My commandments and keeps them, it is he who loves Me. And he who loves Me will be loved by My Father, and I will love him and manifest Myself to him.

- Has a thankful spirit
- Has a submissive and respectful spirit
