Introduction

A true Christian is not without fruits. Christian life should manifest the kind of life that the Lord Jesus Christ desires for everyone that believes in Him and follows Him. In other words, everyone who claims to be a Christian should aim to be like Christ—Christlikeness. How can we bear fruit and be like Christ? It is by surrendering our whole life to Him, walking with Him and living according to His will—righteous and holy life. Furthermore, your life should be founded on the principles of the Bible, and doing your share in proclaiming the

Gospel of Christ to the unsaved.

I. The Fruit of Change

a. New creation – New life

2 Corinthians 5:17

Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new.

b. Put off the old man, put on the new man.

PAGSUNOD SA NAIS ng Panginoon

Bilang anak ng Diyos ay lagi tayong mayroong kakaharaping sitwasyon na susubok sa bating pananampalataya sa Kanya. Simula nang tutukan ni Rev. Dr. William Sy ang pagging Punong Pastor ng UCF ay hindi naging madali ang kaniyang mga pinagdaanan. Bagaman may mga maling paniniwala nang simulan ang panambahan, ngunit dahil sa pangungusap ng Panginoon kay Rev. Dr. Sy ay matibay niyang pinagdesisyunan na tuluyan nang talikuran ang mga ito at tapat na sumunod sa katotohanang inihayag sa kanya ng Diyos.

"Na-convict ako ng Lord. Ang mga katoliko, lagi lang sinasabi na hindi naman iyan rebulto at parang mga litrato lang iyan pero niluluhuran nila at pinupunasang din. Ganoon din kami noon ngunit ang lakas ng conviction sa akin ng Lord na tanggalin ang mga rebulto. Isang araw,inalis ko lahat iyon. Pagpasok ng mga miyembro ay nagulat at nagalit sila sa akin. Halos kalahati ng kongregasyon ay nagalit sa akin at nawala sa simbahan. Pero ang conviction sa akin ay tanggalin at sirain na ang mga iyon noong taong 1985."

Nagpatuloy si Rev. Dr. Sy sa kaniyang pagsunod sa Panginoon sa kabilang mga tumalikod sa kanya. Naging malalim siya sa Salita ng Diyos na nakatulong sa kanya upang maunawaan kung ano ang tama. Ang naging pagkakaiba niya ay hindi siya natakor gawin ang tama. "Kapag nalaman ko ang tama, hindi mo ako mapipigilan. Iyon talaga ang gagawin ko." Simula noon ay doon siya nagsimulang magbahagi sa mga Katoliko at malaking pagbabago ang nangyari. "From idol worshipper, tapos nawala na iyon. Ang transition ay mahirap pero willing ako. Hanggang sa binago ako ng Lord. Maging ang way of worship at way of church program ay nag-iba. Naging transformed ang lahat at hanggang sa nag-speak in tongues ako."

Makikita sa buhay ni Rev. Dr. Sy ang pagbabago ng Diyos sa kanya. Dahil sa pangungusap ng Banal na Espiritu ay nalaman niya ang tama sa mali at doon siya buong pusong nagtitiwala. Hindi man naniniwala ang lahat sa kanya, siya ay nanatili at pinanindigan ang pagsunod sa Diyos. May pagkakataon man na napunta siya sa iba't ibang simbahan, ngunit siya ay kinausap muli ng Diyos na mas tutukan ang panambahan ng UCF. "Ang unang pinagawa sa akin ng Lord ay talagang mag-pastor ako nang mabuti kasi dati nag-e-evangelize at nagmimisyon ako. After that, kinausap ako ng Lord to write down the vision at doon na nagsimula ang lahat. Noong sinulat ko iyon, tinatawanan ako dahil parang impossible naman kasi church lang tayo pero bakit may ganiyan? Hanggang sa nag-umpisa kami ng school. Ang ibang worker at elder noong umpsa ay naniwala sa akin ngunit noong mga sumunod ay hindi na. Nagsasalita na sila ng negative, 'Si pastor parang ilusyon lang ang mga sinasabi.' Iyon ang struggle ko."

Marami man ang umalis na manggagawa noong sinimulang sundin ni Rev. Dr. Sy ang mga plano ng Diyos sa panambahan, hindi ito naging dahilan upang siya ay matinag, bagkus ay mas naging matatag pa siya. Dumating ang panahon at nagsimula na ang UCA noon sa UCF Biñan. Ngunit muling nangusap ang Panginoon sa kanya at sinabing itayo ang UCA sa Parañaque taong

1987. "Wala talagang naniniwala that time lalo na kapag sinabi kong kinakausap ako ng Lord. Tinanong nila, 'Bakit ikaw ang kinausap? Parang lumalabas ay parang siraulo talaga. Tapos ang vision na sinasabi mo ay parang hindi talaga kapani-paniwala.' Mayroon akong frustration at depression pero ini-inspire ako ng Lord na gumawa ako ng mga awitin at iyon naman ang nagiging kalakasan ko. Tapos kakausapin ako ng Lord at nakakapagpatuloy ako." Sinabi ng Lord sa kanya, "Kung galit sila sa iyo, Ako ay hindi. Magpatuloy ka lang anak."

May pagkakataon ding nagkaroon ng argumento si Rev. Dr. Sy sa Panginoon dahil sa mga taong ayaw maniwala sa Diyos. "Ayaw mo kasi sila kausapin kaya hindi sila naniniwala." Mayroon Siyang sinabi sa akin kaya tumahimik nalang ako.

Ang sabi Niya sa akin ay 'Hindi naman sila ang lingkod ko, ikaw.' Kaya tumahimik nalang ako. Paano nga naman sila kakausapin, hindi naman sila ang lingkod. Kasi sa isang church, isa lang talaga ang kinakausap ng Diyos."

Iba't iba man ang naging karanasan ni Rev. Dr. Sy ay nagpatuloy siya sa pagsunod sa nais ng Panginoon sa panambahan ng UCF at nagtiwala sa kayang gawin ng Diyos sa kaniyang buhay. Ang kaniyang buhay ay nagsisilbing inspirasyon na dapat tularan lalo na ng mga nagsisimula pa lamang sa Diyos. Purihin ang Diyos sa buhay ng Kaniyang lingkod na patuloy





WHY READ THE BOOK OF JOHN?
