Decision

- It is what separates a family who is harmonious from a family who is broken.

Decision is what makes your **destiny**.

Background

- The passage is about David's passing of his legacy to his son Solomon about the decisions that he needs to do in his life as the next king and the builder of the temple.
- These were all based on what David, the man after God's own heart, has experienced in his whole life as he established an intimate relationship with God.

As believers of Christ, we need

to make wise decisions everyday.

1. Decide to know God. (v. 9)

Joshua 1:8

This Book of the Law shall not depart from your mouth, but you shall meditate in it day and night, that you may observe to do according to all that is written in it. For then you will make your way prosperous, and then you will have good success.

a. Know God personally.

- Have an intimate relationship with God.
- Spend quality time knowing God by meditating His Word, praying, and worshipping Him day and night.

b. Know that God has a purpose in your life.

- Not only that you know what you want to do in your life every day
- But you may know carefully what God wants you to do in your life every day

2. Decide to serve God. (v. 9)

Joshua 24:14-15

serve Him in sincerity and in truth, and put away the gods which your fathers served on the other side of the River and in Egypt. Serve the Lord! ¹⁵And if it seems evil to you to serve the Lord, choose for yourselves this day whom you will serve, whether the gods which your

house, we will serve the Lord."

a. Serve God with a loyal heart.

- For the Lord searches our hearts
- Put away the other gods and idols in your life.
- Serve God with a heart that clings only to God whether in difficulties or victories.

b. Serve God with a willing mind.

- For the Lord understands all the intent of our thoughts.
- Put away the doubts, fears, and excuses that hinder you to serve.
- Serve God with willingness and total submission to follow.

3. Decide to Seek God. (v. 9)

But seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things shall be added to you.
