Introduction

Jesus describes Himself as the "True Vine" and His disciples as the "branches".

Remaining in the vine is life because it produces fruits.

- God is the gardener who takes care of the branches so that they may bear fruit.
- I. Two Categories of Branches: The Fruitless and the Fruitful
- a. The branches that cease to bear fruit are those who no longer have the life that comes from the enduring faith and the

love for Christ.

- The father cuts off these branches and separates them from Christ.

Matthew 3:10

And even now the ax is laid to the root of the trees. Therefore every tree which does not bear good fruit is cut down and thrown into the fire.

 When they stop remaining in Christ, God then judges and rejects them.

John 15:6

If anyone does not abide in Me, he is cast out as a branch and is withered; and they gather them and throw them into the fire, and they are burned.

- b. The branches that bear fruit are those who have life in them because of their enduring faith and their love for Christ.
- These branches the Father prunes so that they will become more fruitful.
- The Father removes anything that diverts and hinders the life flow of Christ in their life.
- The fruit is the quality of "Christian character" that brings glory and honor in their life witnessing.

Matthew 7:20

Therefore by their fruits you will know them.

But now having been set free from sin, and having become slaves of God, you have your fruit to holiness, and the end, everlasting life.



Earthquake Preparedness:



arthquakes may happen anytime without prior notice. Preparing for this natural disaster will make a difference to protect yourself, your family, and your home. Experts say that Metro Manila could be hit by a magnitude 7.2 earthquake anytime because of the West Valley Fault. This earthquake is referred as the "Big One" and is expected to have casualties of more than 33,500 people and can destroy about 40% of the structures.



To prepare for earthquakes, National Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council (NDRRMC) advises that you prepare three things: your home, your family, and your community.

BEFORE AN EARTHQUAKE



Survey your home and office for potential hazards.

Put together your household emergency kits. Review and restock your existing supplies.





Make a family emergency plan and distribute an emergency plan card to each family member.

Make copies of your important documents.





Educate yourself on the risks and how to be more prepared.



DURINGAN EARTHQUAKE

DROP, COVER AND HOLD









Stay inside your building and stay calm. Do not panic.

Take cover beneath strong pieces of furniture and protect your head and neck.





Stay away from glass, window, outside door and wall, and anything that could fall.

If you're in bed, stay there and protect your head and neck with pillows and sheets.



DO NOT TRY TO LEAVE THE BUILDING.
YOU WILL BE AT GREATER RISK
FROM FALLING DEBRIS.

AFTER AN EARTHQUAKE

Check yourself for injuries then help the people around you. Check for potential dangers like fires and structural damages. Be aware that loose items could fall off shelves. If your building is sound, it is normally safer to remain inside as going outside may put you at risk from falling debris.



- As Christians, they have to walk and choose to remain in Christ.

Note

The Greek word meno means:

- To remain
- To continue
- To abide
- To live in Christ

That is why Christ's life flows only by remaining in Christ.

Four Conditions to Remain in Christ

- Keep God's Word continually by heart, soul, and Spirit; and make it your guide to your life ministry.
- Maintain your constant intimate communion and relationship with Christ through prayer and meditation.
- 3. Obey and trust in His love.

John 15:10

If you keep My commandments, you will abide in My love, just as I have kept My Father's commandments and abide in His love.

John 15:12, 17

¹²This is My commandment, that you love one another as I have loved you.

¹⁷These things I command you, that you love one another.

4. Keep your life clean by resisting

all sins and yielding to the Holy Spirit.

John 15:3

You are already clean because of the word which I have spoken to you.

Romans 8:14

For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, these are sons of God.

1 Peter 1:22

Since you have purified your souls in obeying the truth through the Spirit in sincere love of the brethren, love one another fervently with a pure heart.

The parable or allegory of the vine and branches makes it unmistakably clear that Christ did not believe that "once in the vine, always in the vine".

Rather, Jesus gave His disciples a solemn but loving warning that it is indeed possible for true believers to abandon faith, turn their backs on Jesus, and fail to remain in Him and thus, to be thrown into His everlasting fire of hell.

Our relationship with God is rather progressive and never static.

John 17:3

And this is eternal life, that they may know You, the only true God, and Jesus Christ whom You have sent.

1 John 5:11-13

¹¹And this is the testimony: that God has given us eternal life, and this life is in His Son. ¹²He who has the Son has life; he who does not have the Son of God does not have

life. ¹³These things I have written to you who believe in the name of the Son of God, that you may know that you have eternal life, and that you may continue to believe in the name of the Son of God.

It all starts with God.

Colossians 1:16

For by Him all things were created that are in heaven and that are on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or principalities or powers. All things were created through Him and for Him.

The purpose of your life "calling"

is far more greater than your own personal fulfillment. It is far more greater than your family, your career, your peace of mind, and even your wildest dream in life.

Note

If you want to know why you are called by God:

- You must begin with God because you were born with His purpose.
- You won't discover your life purpose by just looking at yourself.
 Begin to discover your life purpose by discovering God's meaning and plans for your life.
