Proverbs 31:28-29 (NKJV)

²⁸Her children rise up and call her blessed; Her husband also, and he praises her: ²⁹"Many daughters have done well, But you excel them all."

Introduction

What comes to your mind whenever you hear the word "mother"?

As believers of Christ, we can learn from motherhood experiences that are relevant in our daily Christian walk.

1. The Motherhood's Difficulties

a. Eve: The first mother lost one of her children at the hands of the other. (Genesis 4:8)

b. Rebekah: Isaac's wife struggled with favoritism of her son Jacob over Esau. (Genesis 25:27-28)

c. Jochebed: A caring mother gave up her son Moses. (Exodus 2:7-10)

d. Hannah: A barren woman prayed persistently to God and kept her promise after God answered her prayer. (1 Samuel 1:1-28)

e. Mary: A grieving mother watched her son Jesus get crucified. (John 19:25-27)

These stories remind us all that relationships between mothers and children are not perfect, and God is at work even in those tough situations.

Our great assurance is that God is at work in redeeming our

biggest mistakes and accidents—for both parents and children in Christ.

Romans 8:28

And we know that all things work together for good to those who love God, to those who are the called according to His purpose.

2. The Motherly Characteristics of God

a. God is concerned with His people like a midwife cares for the child she has delivered.

Psalms 22:9-10

⁹But You are He who took Me out of the womb; You made Me trust while on My mother's breasts. ¹⁰I was cast upon You from birth. From My mother's womb You have been My God.

b. God will never forget His children like a mother who will not forget nursing her child.

Isaiah 49:15

"Can a woman forget her nursing child, And not have compassion on the son of her womb? Surely they may forget, Yet I will not forget you."

c. God comforts His people like a nursing mother.

Isaiah 66:13

"As one whom his mother comforts, So I will comfort you; And

you shall be comforted in Jerusalem."

d. God cares for His people like an eagle hovering over her young.

Deuteronomy 32:11

As an eagle stirs up its nest, Hovers over its young, Spreading out its wings, taking them up, Carrying them on its wings.

e. God experiences the anger of a mother like a bear who has been robbed of her cubs.

Hosea 13:8

I will meet them like a bear deprived of her cubs; I will tear open their rib cage, And there I will devour them like a lion. The wild beast shall tear them.

3. The Motherhood's Legacies

a. Mothers should teach their children diligently on how to live a godly life.

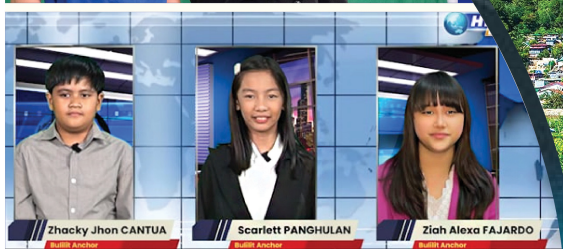


News anchors cover different news reports that are up to date.

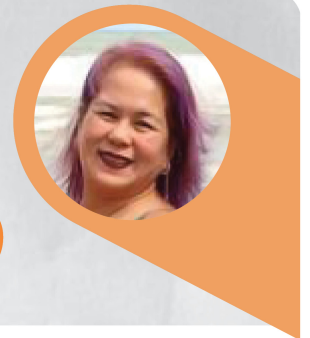

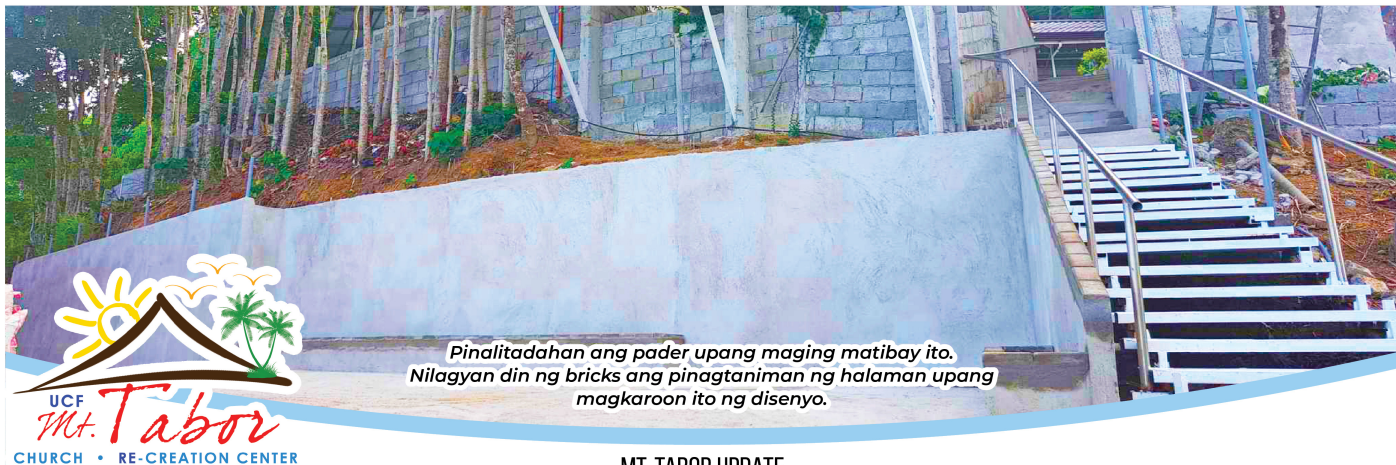
