- steadfast, continuing in a strong and steady way
- that believers have unwavering faith in God
- having a complete trust or confidence in His Word

I. What causes wavering faith?

- 1. Trials and hardships, or when faced with difficult situations
- 2. Temptation and distraction
- It is easy to become distracted by worldly temptation.

James 1:12-13 (NIV)

¹²Blessed is the one who perseveres under trial because, having stood the test, that person will receive the crown of life that the Lord has promised to those who love Him. 13When tempted, no one should say, "God is tempting me." For God cannot be tempted by evil, nor does He tempt anyone.

II. How do we have faith in God during trials?

1. Choose to trust God.

Proverbs 3:5-6 (NKJV)

⁵Trust in the Lord with all your heart, And lean not on your own understanding; 6In all your ways acknowledge Him, And He shall direct your paths.

- This is demonstrating faith.
- If you want to have unwavering faith, you need to make the decision every day to just say, "I trust You, God."

John 14:1 (NIV)

"Do not let your hearts be troubled. You believe in God; believe also in Me."

Psalm 37:3 (NKJV)

Trust in the Lord, and do good; Dwell in the land, and feed on His faithfulness.

2. Know the Truth.

John 8:32 (NIV)

"Then you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free."

- The Truth sets us free from discouragement.
- Focus on Jesus who is the Truth.

Hebrews 12:2

(NIV)

Fixing our eyes on Jesus, the pioneer and perfecter of faith. For the joy set before Him He endured the cross, scorning its shame, and sat down at the right hand of the throne of God.

- Looking unto Him and His truth

3. Trials prepare us for service.

- When God works in a big way, it often involves one of His servants facing big trials.

Romans 5:2-5 (NIV)

²Through whom we have gained access by faith into this grace in which we now stand. And we boast in the hope of the glory of God. 3Not only so, but we also glory in our sufferings, because we know that suffering produces perseverance: ⁴perseverance, character; and character, hope. 5And hope does not put us to shame, because God's love has been poured out into our hearts through the Holy Spirit, who has been given to us.

- The disciples exhausted all their efforts before they went to Jesus.
- The storm is not where you face your doom, it is where you meet your God.

- So trust in His presence to be with you in the storm of life.
- 3. Believers have unwavering faith in His power.
