<sup>21</sup>"Not everyone who says to Me, 'Lord, Lord,' shall enter the kingdom of heaven, but he who does the will of My Father in heaven. <sup>22</sup>Many will say to Me in that day, 'Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in Your name, cast out demons in Your name, and done many wonders in Your name?' <sup>23</sup>And then I will declare to them, 'I never knew you; depart from Me, you who practice lawlessness!'"

Genuine faith means that God changed your heart to love God and obey His commandments.

### Ephesians 2:8-10

It is clear that faith comes first, and that faith comes from God. Now good works are evidences of the genuine faith. We are His workmanship.

# Hebrews 9:27

And as it is appointed for men to die once, but after this the judgment.

# Matthew 25:46

"And these will go away into everlasting punishment, but the righteous into eternal life."

**Eternal life** includes glory, honor, immortality, and peace (v. 7, 10).

# John 17:3

And this is eternal life, that they may know You, the only true God, and Jesus Christ whom You have sent.

- **Glory** refers to our transformation into the image of Jesus Christ, where God's glory will be reflected in us.

#### Romans 8:21

Because the creation itself also will be delivered from the bondage of corruption into the glorious liberty of the children of God.

- Honor refers to God's approval.

## Matthew 25:21

His lord said to him, 'Well done, good and faithful servant; you were faithful over a few things, I will make you ruler over many things. Enter into the joy of your lord.'

- Immortality refers to receiving new bodies.

# 1 Corinthians 15:53

For this corruptible must put on incorruption, and this mortal must put on immortality.

- **Peace** refers to peace with God and peace of heart and mind in the full enjoyment of God to all eternity.

<sup>4</sup>When Christ who is our life appears, then you also will appear with Him in glory.

Eternal wrath includes tribulation and distress (v.8-9).

#### Romans 1:18

For the wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men, who suppress the truth in unrighteousness.

Tribulation and distress are both suffering experience. You don't want to experience these eternally.

B. Judgement is individual and impartial: does good or does evil

#### Jeremiah 17:10

I, the Lord, search the heart, I test the mind, Even to give every man according to his ways, According to the fruit of his doings.

#### Matthew 16:27

For the Son of Man will come in the glory of His Father with His angels, and then He will reward each according to his works.

#### 2 Corinthians 5:10

Have you experienced the power of God in salvation through Jesus Christ?


