#### Philippians 3:12-14 (NKJV)

12Not that I have already attained, or am already perfected; but I press on, that I may lay hold of that for which Christ Jesus has also laid hold of me. 13Brethren, I do not count myself to have apprehended; but one thing I do, forgetting those things which are behind and reaching forward to those things which are ahead, 14I press toward the goal for the prize of the upward call of God in Christ Jesus.

#### Introduction

As believers of Christ, God is calling you for the following:

#### 1. Call to repentance

#### Mark 2:17

When Jesus heard it. He said to them, "Those who are well have no need of a physician, but those who are sick. I did not come to call the righteous, but sinners, to repentance."

- a. Turning away from sin not being self-righteous nor comparing yourself to others' failures
- b. Turning to God humbly acknowledging that you need God's forgiveness, cleansing and restoration

#### 2. Call to a holy life

#### 1 Thessalonians 4:7

For God did not call us to uncleanness, but in holiness.

a. Not to uncleanness - not to continue on practicing sin, neither be polluted nor corrupted by the lust of this world

#### b. But

#### in holiness

- sanctified life separated from these worldly pleasures

#### 3. Call to walk according to God's kingdom and glory

#### 1 Thessalonians 2:12

That you would walk worthy of God who calls you into His own kingdom and glory.

- a. Walking according to God's Kingdom - God works in the way you think, speak, and live through the Holy Spirit.
- b. Walking according to God's Glory - God's light shines in your life as other people see God's presence and work.

#### 4. Call to do God's purpose and grace

#### 2 Timothy 1:9

Who has saved us and called us with a holy calling, not according to our works, but according to His own purpose and grace which was given to us in Christ Jesus before time began.

- a. Not according to our own good works - not what we want to do nor even what we want to do for God
- b. Do according to God's own purpose - Do what God wants you to do and serve Him.
- c. Do according to God's own grace. If you have done what God wanted you to do, then you will experience His grace; God will do His part.

#### 5. Call to endure life's trials

#### 1 Peter 5:10

But may the God of all grace, who called us to His eternal glory by Christ Jesus, after you have suffered a while, perfect, establish, strengthen, and settle you.

### 6. Call to be faithful until the

#### 1 Timothy 6:12

Fight the good fight of faith, lay hold on eternal life, to which you were also called and have confessed the good confession in the presence of many witnesses.

#### 7. Call to inherit blessing

#### 1 Peter 3:8-9

8Finally, all of you be of one mind, having compassion for one another; love as brothers, be tenderhearted, be courteous: 9not returning evil for evil or reviling for reviling, but on the contrary blessing, knowing that you were called to this, that you may inherit a blessing.




