Walk in Him

Colossians 2:6-8 (NKJV)

⁶As you therefore have received Christ Jesus the Lord, so walk in Him, ⁷rooted and built up in Him and established in the faith, as you have been taught, abounding in it with thanksgiving. ⁸Beware lest anyone cheat you through philosophy and empty deceit, according to the tradition of men, according to the basic principles of the world, and not according to Christ.

Introduction

When a person received or believed in Jesus Christ, he or she then becomes a child of God according to the will of God.

John 1:12-13

¹²But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God, to those who believe in His name: ¹³who were born, not of blood, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man, but of God

The Holy Spirit also bears witness that we are children of God and heirs to the promise of God.

Romans 8:16-17a

¹⁶The Spirit Himself bears witness with our spirit that we are children of God, ¹⁷and if children, then heirs—heirs of God and joint heirs with Christ.

Most church teachings end here. But, why? Let us continue.

Romans 8:17b

If indeed we suffer with Him, that we may also be glorified together.

Why? Because many are afraid of sufferings. Many do not want to walk in Him. They do not wish to be

Christ's disciples nor to carry his own cross and follow Christ Jesus the Lord.

Matthew 10:38-39

³⁸And he who does not take his cross and follow after Me is not worthy of Me. ³⁹He who finds his life will lose it, and he who loses his life for My sake will find it.

Apostle Paul is not focusing so much on the means of how you received Jesus Christ (by grace through faith), but rather on the Christ whom you received because false teachers set aside or minimized Jesus Christ with their clever philosophies—denying the fullness of Christ and adding or replacing them with man-made teachings.

So if you want to avoid the deceptions of the false teachers, follow and walk in Him.

A. "Christ Jesus the Lord" is the one whom we received.

"Christ Jesus the Lord" counteracts three false conceptions of the Savior.

Christ - He is the Messiah, the Anointed One. He is the one prophesied as God's anointed King, Prophet, and Priest.

Jesus – His human name represents His humanity. Since we cannot be with the Holy God, God through Christ Jesus came into the world to save those who believed in His name.

Romans 10:13

For "whoever calls on the name of the Lord shall be saved."

Philippians 2:9-11

Therefore God also has highly exalted Him and given Him the name which is above every name, ¹⁰that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of those in heaven, and of those on earth, and of those under the earth, ¹¹and that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

The Lord – We are His servants. He gives commands and we obey.

Many were led to believe that if they received Jesus Christ as their Savior, they will be saved. This is false. Jesus Christ is both Lord and Savior.

B. The gospel is not a human philosophy.

Romans 10:14-17

¹⁴How then shall they call on Him in whom they have not believed? And how shall they believe in Him of whom they have not heard?



And how shall they hear without a preacher? ¹⁵And how shall they preach unless they are sent? As it is written: "How beautiful are the feet of those who preach the gospel of peace, Who bring glad tidings of good things!" ¹⁶But they have not all obeyed the gospel. For Isaiah says, "Lord, who has believed our report?" ¹⁷So then faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.

The gospel was transmitted to us from Jesus Christ through His chosen (sent). As we walk, we grow deeper in the knowledge of who Jesus is and how we can live in a way that is pleasing to Him.

Colossians 1:10

That you may walk worthy of the Lord, fully pleasing Him, being fruitful in every good work and increasing in the knowledge of God.

Saving faith is more than just intellectual assent. Did you add Jesus into your life as a nice accessory to gain answered prayers and to fulfill your life's goals and aspirations (blessings)? No, you must receive Christ Jesus the Lord. He owns us because He bought us with His blood.

C. Walk in Him.

After we received Christ Jesus the Lord, then we walk in Him. Walking indicates an ongoing process like these four participles:

Rooted in Him – Most of the time, we cannot see the roots, but we can only see the tree and its fruits. When your roots go deeper, your tree gets bigger. When the storm comes, you will not crash if you are rooted in Him.


Built up in Him – If Jesus is your foundation (the rock), your house will not fall.

Established in the faith – To be established in the faith is to grow in the knowledge of God so that we can guard our hearts and minds.

Overflowing with gratitude (thanksgiving) – Overflowing is a picture of too much water that the container can no longer hold. Our thanksgiving should be overflowing.

Conclusion

Christians can only be deceived when they stopped walking in Him.
