Come to Me Take My Yoke - Learn from S

Matthew 11:28-30 (NKJV)

²⁸"Come to Me, all you who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. ²⁹Take My yoke upon you and learn from Me, for I am gentle and lowly in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. ³⁰For My yoke is easy and My burden is light."

Introduction

Matthew 11 begins with John the Baptist being in prison and sending two of his disciples to ask Jesus about his doubts.

v. 4-6 – ⁴Jesus answered and said to them, "Go and tell John the things which you hear and see: ⁵The blind see and the lame walk; the lepers are cleansed and the deaf hear; the dead are raised up and the poor have the gospel preached to them. ⁶And blessed is he who is not offended because of Me."

Jesus went around Israel proclaiming the Gospel of the Kingdom, calling people to turn from sin (repent) and be baptized, and performing various healings and miracles. But people were increasingly irresponsive, even though many followed Jesus, they did not recognize Jesus as the King and that the Kingdom of God has arrived. They never repented, for they saw Jesus as a miracle worker and a teacher.

So, Jesus began to denounce (v. 20-24 - Woe to you.) the cities, where He traveled and performed the power of the Kingdom. The people in those cities were stubborn and hardened their hearts. They even accused Jesus of being the Devil.

When a criminal whose words and actions convey unrepentance, will

you grant him a pardon?

Unbelief is a moral disobedience and not an intellectual skepticism. It is the human pride of independence saying, "Who is lord over us?" or "Why should we depend on you?" Unbelief asks for more evidences and when presented, still denies its existence. Unbelief is the refusal to submit to the truth. But an honest man will follow the evidences.

Romans 1:18-32

¹⁸For the wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men, who suppress the truth in unrighteousness, 19because what may be known of God is manifest in them, for God has shown it to them. ²⁰For since the creation of the world His invisible attributes are clearly seen, being understood by the things that are made, even His eternal power and Godhead, so that they are without excuse, 21because, although they knew God, they did not glorify Him as God, nor were thankful, but became futile in their thoughts, and their foolish hearts were darkened. ²²Professing to be wise, they became fools, 23 and changed the glory of the incorruptible God into an image made like corruptible man-and birds and four-footed animals and creeping things. 24Therefore God also gave them up to uncleanness, in the lusts of their hearts, to dishonor their bodies among themselves, 25 who exchanged the truth of God for the lie, and worshiped and served the rather than the Creator, who is blessed forever. Amen. 26For this reason God gave them up to vile passions. For even their women exchanged the natural use for what is against nature. 27Likewise also the men, leaving the natural use of the woman, burned in their lust for one another, men with men committing what is shameful, and receiving in themselves the penalty of their error which was due. 28And even as they did not like to retain God in their knowledge, God gave them over to a debased mind, to do those things which are not fitting; 29being filled with all unrighteousness, sexual immorality, wickedness, covetousness, maliciousness; full of envy, murder, strife, deceit, evilmindedness; they are whisperers, 30 backbiters, haters of God, violent, proud, boasters, inventors of evil things, disobedient to parents, 31undiscerning, untrustworthy, unloving, unforgiving, unmerciful; 32who, knowing the righteous judgment of God, that those who practice such things are deserving of death, not only do the same but also approve of those who practice them.





Jesus responded in prayer and in an invitation.

v. 25-27 - ²⁵At that time Jesus answered and said, "I thank You, Father, Lord of heaven and earth, that You have hidden these things from the wise and prudent and have revealed them to babes. ²⁶Even so, Father, for so it seemed good in Your sight. ²⁷All things have been delivered to Me by My Father, and no one knows the Son except the Father. Nor does anyone know the Father except the Son, and the one to whom the Son wills to reveal Him.

Even though God is sovereign, He will not reduce our responsibility to choose, to believe, to refuse, etc.

John 1:11

He came to His own, and His own

did not receive Him.

A. Come to Me

God sent an invitation to all, but it is our responsibility to respond and to come to Jesus. To come to Jesus means to acknowledge that we need Him (to believe) and to make Him our life (to receive).

Religion added human philosophy and ordinances above the Law of God. These became the works and the burdens of the people who wanted reconciliation with God. Religion teaches sacrifices for the forgiveness of sins and good works to receive salvation. These became the yoke of humanity: self-righteousness (sacrifices) and good works (merits). These cannot give us rest. Only Jesus can give us

v. 28 - Come to Me, all you who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. Jesus is saying, "Come and I will give you forgiveness, redemption, and salvation." (Rest for our souls)

B. Take My yoke

A yoke is a wooden plank fastened over the neck of an ox and attached to the plow or cart that they are to pull.

When Jesus said, "Take my yoke", He is saying that we should be yoked together. He is not putting or leaving you with a yoke to pull for yourself. Religion forced that yoke on us, but Jesus carried it to the cross for us. Jesus fulfilled the law.

To be yoked together is when two or more oxen are fastened together to pull the plow or the cart. It becomes easy and light because you are not pulling alone. The best part of it is that Jesus is the older ox (bigger, experienced, and stronger) and we are the young ox (smaller, inexperienced, and weaker).

Who do you think is the one pulling the most of the plow or the cart?

C. Learn from Me

We should abide and learn from the examples of Jesus. He showed

- With God, all things are possible. Matthew 19:26


But Jesus looked at them and said to them, "With men this is impossible, but with God all things are possible."
