Galatians 5:19-26 (NKJV)

19Now the works of the flesh are evident, which are: adultery. fornication, uncleanness, lewdness, 20idolatry, sorcery. hatred. contentions, jealousies, outbursts wrath, selfish ambitions, of dissensions, heresies. 21envy, murders, drunkenness, revelries, and the like; of which I tell you beforehand, just as I also told you in time past, that those who practice such things will not inherit the kingdom of God. 22But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, ²³gentleness, self-control. Against such there is no law. 24And those who are Christ's have crucified the flesh with its passions and desires. ²⁵If we live in the Spirit, let us also walk in the Spirit. 26Let us not become conceited, provoking one another, envying one another.

Self-control

- It is the ninth fruit of the Spirit.
- It means having power over your body's desires and passions.
- It is impossible to succeed in anything without some degree of self-control.
- We need self-control for health reasons, for completing everyday tasks, and for positive relationships with other people.
- For Christians, self-control is a necessity for living a new life in Christ.

A lack of self-control will destroy your life.

- The Bible points out a number of areas where we especially need to exert selfcontrol, such as overeating, greed and the accumulation of wealth, gambling, drunkenness, drug abuse, anger, emotional outbursts, and sexual immorality.
- Many people's lives have been destroyed even by one moment of lacking in self-control.

As believers of Christ, we should understand how to live daily with self-control.

1. Self-control and God

The fruit of the Spirit is rooted in God's character. God is the root and we bear the fruit.

a. God is sovereign and in control of all things.

Ephesians 1:11 (NKJV)

In Him also we have obtained an inheritance, being predestined according to the purpose of Him who works all things according to the counsel of His will.

Philippians 3:20-21 (NKJV)

²⁰For our citizenship is in heaven, from which we also eagerly wait for the Savior, the Lord Jesus Christ, ²¹who will transform our lowly body that it may be conformed to His glorious body, according to the working by which He is able even to subdue all things to Himself.

b. God's wrath
is His controlled
and righteous anger
against sin.

Romans 1:18 (NKJV)

For the wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men, who suppress the truth in unrighteousness.

Romans 2:5 (NKJV)

But in accordance with your hardness and your impenitent heart you are treasuring up for yourself wrath in the day of wrath and revelation of the righteous judgment of God.

Romans 9:22 (NKJV)

What if God, wanting to show His wrath and to make His power known, endured with much longsuffering the vessels of wrath prepared for destruction.

c. Jesus demonstrated the perfect self-control in His life.

Hebrews 4:15 (NKJV)

For we do not have a High Priest who cannot sympathize with our weaknesses, but was in all points tempted as we are, yet without sin.

Matthew 21:12-13 (NKJV)

¹²Then Jesus went into the temple of God and drove out all those who bought and sold in the temple, and overturned the tables of the money changers and the seats of those who sold doves. ¹³And He said to them, "It is written, 'My house shall be called a house of prayer,' but you have made it a 'den of thieves.'"

Luke 23:34 (NKJV)

Then Jesus said, "Father, forgive them, for they do not know what they do." And they divided His garments and cast lots.

2. Self-control, temptation, and desire

a. Temptation attacks you through your old sinful desires. James 1:12-15 (NKJV)

¹²Blessed is the man who endures temptation; for when he has been approved, he will receive the crown of life which the Lord has promised to those who love Him. ¹³Let no one say when he is tempted, "I am tempted by God"; for God cannot be tempted by evil, nor does He Himself tempt anyone. ¹⁴But each one is tempted when he is drawn away by his own desires and enticed. ¹⁵Then, when desire has conceived, it gives birth to sin; and sin, when it is full-grown, brings forth death.

b. The Holy Spirit gives you new and right desires.

Galatians 5:16-18 (NKJV)

¹⁶I say then: Walk in the Spirit, and you shall not fulfill the lust of the flesh. ¹⁷For the flesh lusts against the Spirit, and the Spirit against the flesh; and these are contrary to one

another, so that you do not do the things that you wish. ¹⁸But if you are led by the Spirit, you are not under the law.

c. Part of self-control is setting your mind on what the Spirit desires.

Romans 8:5-8 (NKJV)

⁵For those who live according to the flesh set their minds on the things of the flesh, but those who live according to the Spirit, the things of the Spirit. ⁶For to be carnally minded is death, but to be spiritually minded is life and peace. ⁷Because the carnal mind is enmity against God; for it is not subject to the law of God, nor indeed can be. ⁸So then, those who are in the flesh cannot please God.

3. How can we grow in self-control?

a. Practice self-discipline.

Proverbs 25:28 (NIV)

Like a city whose walls are broken through is a person who lacks selfcontrol.

1 Corinthians 9:24-27 (NKJV)

²⁴Do you not know that those who run in a race all run, but one receives the prize? Run in such a way that you may obtain it. ²⁵And everyone who competes for the prize is temperate in all things. Now they do it to obtain a perishable crown, but we for an imperishable crown. ²⁶Therefore I run thus: not with uncertainty. Thus I fight: not as one who beats the air. ²⁷But I discipline my body and bring it into subjection, lest, when I have preached to others, I myself should become disqualified.

2 Peter 1:5-6 (NKJV)

⁵But also for this very reason, giving all diligence, add to your faith virtue, to virtue knowledge, ⁶to knowledge self-control, to self-control perseverance, to perseverance godliness.

b. Beware of addictions.

Galatians 5:19-21 (NKJV)

c. Don't give in to anger or fear.

James 1:19-20 (NKJV)

¹⁹So then, my beloved brethren, let every man be swift to hear, slow to speak, slow to wrath; ²⁰for the wrath of man does not produce the righteousness of God.

2 Timothy 1:7 (NKJV)

For God has not given us a spirit of fear, but of power and of love and of a sound mind.

d. Ask God to develop the fruit of self-control in your life.

Titus 2:12-13 (NKJV)

¹²Teaching us that, denying ungodliness and worldly lusts, we should live soberly, righteously, and godly in the present age, ¹³looking for the blessed hope and glorious appearing of our great God and Savior Jesus Christ.

Challenge

Galatians 5:25 (NKJV)

If we live in the Spirit, let us also walk in the Spirit.

- Have self-control with love love for God, love for Jesus, love for other people.
- Always think before you act.
- Give your life fully to God's control!

Matthew 5:16 (NKJV)
