DEAD TO SIN **VOICE OF THE**

Romans 6:5-11 (NKJV)

⁵For if we have been united together in the likeness of His death, certainly we also shall be in the likeness of His resurrection, 6knowing this, that our old man was crucified with Him, that the body of sin might be done away with, that we should no longer be slaves of sin. 7For he who has died has been freed from sin. 8Now if we died with Christ, we believe that we shall also live with Him, 9knowing that Christ, having been raised from the dead, dies no more. Death no longer has dominion over Him. 10 For the death that He died. He died to sin once for all; but the life that He lives, He lives to God. "Likewise you also, reckon yourselves to be dead indeed to sin, but alive to God in Christ Jesus our Lord.

Introduction

- Why do people struggle with sin?
- Is it possible that a person who follows Christ still sins?

I. The Law of Sin and Death

In Genesis 1, God created everything and it was good (perfect). Then in Genesis 3, sin entered the picture. Because of sin, man became dead to God. This death means separation from God. Adam and Eve did not literally die physically, but they were separated from God (taken out of the Garden of Eden). They were subjected to physical death, which is not in the original plan of God (even the whole creation was subjected to this death).

Genesis 3:17

Then to Adam He said, "Because you have heeded the voice of your wife, and have eaten from the tree of which I commanded you, saying, 'You shall not eat of it': "Cursed is the ground for your sake; In toil you shall eat of it all the days of your life."

Romans 8:22

For we know that the whole creation groans

and labors with birth pangs together until now.

Sin caused death and sin caused our fallen nature, and we became under the Law of Sin and Death. And according to this law, the penalty of sin is death.

Shall we conclude that this law is sin?

Romans 7:7-12

What shall we say then? Is the law sin? Certainly not! On the contrary, I would not have known sin except through the law. For I would not have known covetousness unless the law had said. "You shall not covet." 8But sin, taking opportunity by the commandment, produced in me all manner of evil desire. For apart from the law sin was dead. 9I was alive once without the law, but when the commandment came, sin revived and I died. 10 And the commandment, which was to bring life, I found to bring death. "For sin, taking occasion by the commandment, deceived me, and by it killed me. 12 Therefore the law is holy, and the commandment holy and just and good.

Sin is not the actual action of wrongdoing. Sin is our state of being, separated from God. This is why people have the desire to do all evil things because we are apart from God, and we are not under His will.

When Jesus came into the world:

- He fulfilled the Law.
- He became sin.
- He experienced death.

Why? To redeem us from the penalty of sin. Romans 8:3-4

After Jesus' resurrection, He introduced a new law-the Law of Spirit of Life in Christ Jesus.

Romans 8:1-2

¹There is therefore now no condemnation

to those who are in Christ Jesus, who do not walk according to the flesh, but according to the Spirit, 2For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus has made me free from the law of sin and death.

II. The Law of Spirit of Life in Christ Jesus

How can we be under this new law? It is by accepting Jesus as our Lord and Savior.

Romans 8:1

There is therefore now no condemnation to those who are in Christ Jesus, who do not walk according to the flesh, but according to the Spirit.

Because of this law, we are freed from the Law of Sin and Death.

Romans 8:2

For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus has made me free from the law of sin and death.

Because of this law, the righteous requirement of the Law of Sin and Death is fulfilled.



God did by sending His own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh, on account of sin: He condemned sin in the flesh, ⁴that the righteous requirement of the law might be fulfilled in us who do not walk according to the flesh but according to the Spirit.

Because of this Law, we have now a new position in God; we are now children of God.

- Raised from the dead (because of sin)
- Death no longer has dominion
- Alive to God in Christ Jesus, our

- We should not obey its lusts (strong desire for anything evil).
- We should not present our bodies as instruments of unrighteousness to sin.
- We should present our body to God as instruments of righteousness.

Romans 12:1-2

'I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that you present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable to God, which is your reasonable service. ²And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God.

III. A true follower of Christ has the Holy Spirit of God in him.

- The indwelling of the Holy Spirit in us is a proof that we are now under the Law of Spirit of Life in Christ Jesus.
- The Holy Spirit enables us to walk in holiness
- We cannot say that we are alive if the Holy Spirit is not in us.

Romans 8:9-11

But you are not in the flesh but in the Spirit, if indeed the Spirit of God dwells in you. Now if anyone does not have the Spirit of Christ, he is not His. ¹⁰And if Christ is in you, the body is dead because of sin, but the Spirit is life because of righteousness. ¹¹But if the Spirit of Him who raised Jesus from the dead dwells in you, He who raised Christ from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies through His Spirit who dwells in you.

The question now is...

- Are you in Christ?

Galatians 5:22-25

²²But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, ²³gentleness, self-control. Against such there is no law. ²⁴And those who are Christ's have crucified the flesh with its passions and desires. ²⁵If we live in the Spirit, let us also walk in the Spirit.

As genuine followers of Christ, we do not struggle with sin because we are already dead in it and we are now alive, born-again of the Spirit.

Challenge

As an ending, let me quote what Moses said to the Israelites when he finished to say all the commandments that the Lord gave for the nation of Israel to obey. This challenge is still applicable for us until this day.

Deuteronomy 30:19-20

¹⁹Icall heaven and earth as witnesses today against you, that I have set before you **life and death**, blessing and cursing; therefore **choose life**, that both you and your descendants may live; ²⁰that you may love the Lord your God, that you may obey His voice, and that you may cling to Him, for **He is your life** and the length of your days.
