Ephesians 2:1-7 (NKJV)

'And you He made alive, who were dead in trespasses and sins, 2in which you once walked according to the course of this world, according to the prince of the power of the air, the spirit who now works in the sons of disobedience, 3 among whom also we all once conducted ourselves in the lusts of our flesh, fulfilling the desires of the flesh and of the mind, and were by nature children of wrath, just as the others. 4But God, who is rich in mercy, because of His great love with which He loved us, 5even when we were dead in trespasses, made us alive together with Christ (by grace you have been saved), 6and raised us up together, and made us sit together in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus, 7that in the ages to come He might show the exceeding riches of His grace in His kindness toward us in Christ Jesus.

Introduction

What is death?

In the perspective of the world, death is:

- near during war and calamities
- near during sickness and accidents
- hopeless and fearful
- the end

The passage is telling the believers on how to overcome death.

A. The Life-Giver: God already gave you a life (v. 1a).

1. Men were dead because of living in the following:

- a. **Trespasses (v. 1b)** swerving aside and falling
- b. Sins (v. 1b) missing of the mark of life; doing evil
- c. Conform (v. 2a) walking according to the course of this world

d. Disobedience

- (v. 2b) walking according to the power of the enemy
- e. Lusts of our flesh (v. 3a)
- fulfilling the desires of the flesh and of the mind

f. Wrath (v. 3b) - violent anger

2. God gave you life through faith in Jesus Christ.

- a. Rich in mercy (v. 4a)
- b. Great love (v. 4b)
- c. Made us alive together in Jesus Christ (v. 5b)
- d. Raised us up together (v. 6a)
- e. Made us sit together in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus (v. 6b)
- f. Exceeding riches of grace in kindness (v. 7)


