¹Paul, an apostle of Jesus Christ by the will of God, To the saints who are in Ephesus, and faithful in Christ Jesus: ²Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ. ³Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places in Christ, ⁴just as He chose us in Him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and without blame before Him in love, ⁵having predestined us to adoption as sons by Jesus Christ to Himself, according to the good pleasure of His will, ⁶to the praise of the glory of His grace, by which He made us accepted in the Beloved.

Introduction

In the first chapter of Ephesians, Paul talked about God's incomparable blessings to us:

- The Father chose us (1:4-6).
- The Son redeemed us (1:7-12),
- The Holy Spirit sealed us (1:13-14).

All of these are "to the praise of His glory." These truths are so profoundly important and deep that Paul prayed that God will open our minds to comprehend the riches of all that God has given to us as members of the body of Christ, the head over all (1:15-23).

God wants us to know who we are in Christ and how we came to be in Christ.

Our conversion and appointment as saints have nothing to do with our clean lifestyle or even being a good person. It all happened

by the sovereign will of God. God has opened our spiritual eyes to see Jesus Christ, our Lord and Savior.

We were spiritually dead because of our sins, living without a purpose, blinded by this world's system, and excluded from the life of God.

Ephesians 2:1-3

¹And you He made alive, who were dead in trespasses and sins, ²in which you once walked according to the course of this world, according to the prince of the power of the air, the spirit who now works in the sons of disobedience, ³among whom also we all once conducted ourselves in the lusts of our flesh, fulfilling the desires of the flesh and of the mind, and were by nature children of wrath, just as the others.

Now that we are believers, the Bible called us "saints". We are those whom God "set apart" for Himself, the bride of Jesus. As the bride (the Church), we are to be holy because He is holy. We are to be faithful because He is faithful. We are to love one another as He loved us. We are to cast ourselves totally on Christ. We are to fix our eyes to Jesus to the end.

1 Corinthians 1:30-31

³⁰But of Him you are in Christ Jesus, who became for us wisdom from God—and righteousness and sanctification and redemption—

³¹that, as it is written, "He who glories, let him glory in the Lord."

Grace is the beginning of our faith. He saved us and blessed us.

Peace is the end of our faith. It is the need of every sinner. Christ reconciled us to God through His death on the cross. Jesus is our peace in trials, persecutions, and sufferings. That is why we continually seek Him and do His will.

I. God has blessed us with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places in Christ.

Why does God bless us? It is so that we may have something to bless and glorify Him.

Proverbs 3:9-10

⁹Honor the Lord with your possessions, And with the firstfruits of all your increase; ¹⁰So your barns will be filled with plenty, And your vats will overflow with new wine.

We cannot bless God in our own way because it is unacceptable before God.

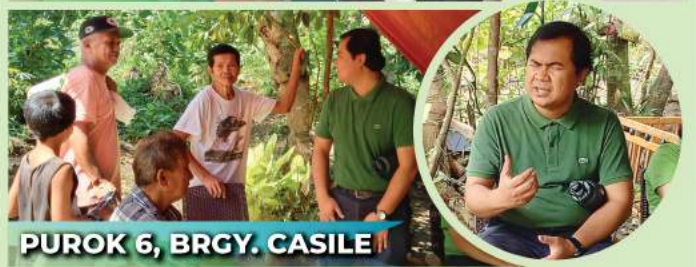

We can only bless God according to His words. We cannot contribute anything to our salvation, not by our works so that no one can boast. We cannot share in God's glory.

Ephesians 2:9

Not of works, lest anyone should boast.

The first blessing of God to us is Jesus Christ. He gave His Son Jesus Christ to save us.

He blessed us with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places, not necessarily with physical or material blessing on Earth. God only promised to provide our basic needs. Material blessing comes when we obey God and serve Him.

1 John 2:15-16

¹⁵Do not love the world or the

things in the world. If anyone loves the world, the love of the Father is not in him. ¹⁶For all that is in the world—the lust of the flesh, the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life—is not of the Father but is of the world.

Colossians 3:1-2

¹If then you were raised with Christ, seek those things which are above, where Christ is, sitting at the right hand of God. ²Set your mind on things above, not on things on the earth.

Matthew 6:33

But seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things shall be added to you.

How then can we bless God? Blessing God means to speak well of Him, to praise Him, to thank Him, to share and do good.

Hebrews 13:15-16

¹⁵Therefore by Him let us

continually offer the sacrifice of praise to God, that is, the fruit of our lips, giving thanks to His name. ¹⁶But do not forget to do good and to share, for with such sacrifices God is well pleased.

II. God has blessed us by choosing us in Christ before the foundation of the world to be holy and blameless.

Why did God choose us? He chose us not based on merit or good works, but it is based on His sovereign pleasure.

We cannot choose God unless God chose us first. Election is unconditional like grace.

Ephesians 2:8-9

⁸For by grace you have been saved through faith, and that not of yourselves; it is the gift of God, ⁹not of works, lest anyone should boast.

Romans 11:5-6

⁵Even so then, at this present time

there is a remnant according to the election of grace. ⁶And if by grace, then it is no longer of works; otherwise grace is no longer grace. But if it is of works, it is no longer grace; otherwise work is no longer work.

Jesus also said that no one can know or come to Him unless He wills it.

Matthew 11:27-30

²⁷"All things have been delivered to Me by My Father, and no one knows the Son except the Father. Nor does anyone know the Father except the Son, and the one to whom the Son wills to reveal Him. ²⁸Come to Me, all you who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. ²⁹Take My yoke upon you and learn from Me, for I am gentle and lowly in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. ³⁰For My yoke is easy and My burden is light."

All these blessings come to us "in Christ". Christ is the center of it all. God called us in Christ. He justified us in Christ. He sanctified us in Christ. He will perfect us in Christ. He will glorify us in Christ. We have everything in Christ, and we have nothing without Christ.

²⁸And we know that all things work together for good to those who love God, to those who are the called according to His purpose. ²⁹For whom He foreknew, He also predestined to be conformed to the image of His Son, that He might be the firstborn among many brethren. ³⁰Moreover whom He predestined, these He also called; whom He called, these He also justified; and whom He justified, these He also glorified.

For this purpose the Son of God was manifested, that He might destroy the works of the devil. ⁹Whoever has been born of God does not sin, for His seed remains in him; and he cannot sin, because

he has been born of God.

Conclusion

Hebrews 4:11-13

¹¹Let us therefore be diligent to enter that rest, lest anyone fall according to the same example of disobedience. ¹²For the word of God is living and powerful, and sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing even to the division of soul and spirit, and of joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart. ¹³And there is no creature hidden from His sight, but all things are naked and open to the eyes of Him to whom we must give account.

The essence of holiness is love. Love is the virtue of a true Christian. It brings forth fruit.

Romans 13:10

Love does no harm to a neighbor; therefore love is the fulfillment of the law.
