¹⁹⁴Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, ²⁰teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age." Amen.

The Lord's commission to believers is sixfold.

 Jesus instructed us to go to all nations and to evangelize them (preach the Gospel).

Note

This task includes the primary responsibility of sending missionaries to every nation.

Acts 13:1-4

Now in the church that was at Antioch there were certain prophets and teachers: Barnabas, Simeon who was called Niger, Lucius of Cyrene, Manaen who had been brought up with Herod the tetrarch, and Saul. ²As they ministered to the Lord and fasted, the Holy Spirit said, "Now separate to Me Barnabas and Saul for the work to which I have called them." 3Then, having fasted and prayed, and laid hands on them, they sent them away. 4So, being sent out by the Holy Spirit, they went down to Seleucia, and from there they sailed to Cyprus.

2. The Gospel preached is centered on "repentance and forgiveness of sins."

The promise of receiving "the gift of the Holy Spirit"

Acts 2:38-39

³⁸Then Peter said to them, "Repent, and let every one of you be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins; and you shall receive the gift of the Holy Spirit. ³⁹For the promise is to you and to your children, and to all who are afar off, as many as the Lord our God will call."

3. The purpose is to make disciples who will observe Christ's commands.

Note

Christ does not intend that evangelism and missionary witness result only in conversion decision, thus merely enlarging church

membership,
but in making
disciples who separate
themselves from the world,
observe the commands of
Christ, and follow Him with all
their heart, mind, and will.

4. Christ commanded us to reach out to the lost souls, not Christianizing society or taking over the world.




