

# KEEPING UNITY OF THE SPIRIT IN THE

### Ephesians 4:1-3 (NKJV)

<sup>1</sup>I, therefore, the prisoner of the Lord, beseech you to walk worthy of the calling with which you were called, <sup>2</sup>with all lowliness and gentleness, with longsuffering, bearing with one another in love, <sup>3</sup>endeavoring to keep the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace.

#### Introduction

In the first three chapters of Ephesians, Paul has shown that the mystery of the gospel includes God bringing together two formerly alienated and hostile groups, the Jews and the Gentiles. He has made them into one new man, establishing peace (2:14-16). In Christ, both groups have access in one Spirit to the Father (2:18). Together, we are being built into a holy temple or dwelling place of God in the Spirit (2:21-22).

Paul states that a worthy walk involves all lowliness (humility), gentleness, longsuffering (patience), bearing (tolerance), and love. These are relational words applied as interpersonal relationships in the church.

The call to follow Christ through the gospel is also a call to grow in loving relationships with one another. The first and the second great commandments are linked (1 John 4:20).

### 1John 4:20

If someone says, "I love God," and hates his brother, he is a liar; for he who does not love his brother whom he has seen, how can he love God whom he has not seen? Paul appeal
to the church
to walk in a

Spirit in the bond of peace.

Unity among believers is a crucial topic in the Bible. Jesus prayed for it just before He went to the cross.

#### John 17:20-23

<sup>20</sup>"I do not pray for these alone, but also for those who will believe in Me through their word; <sup>21</sup>that they all may be one, as You, Father, are in Me, and I in You; that they also may be one in Us, that the world may believe that You sent Me. <sup>22</sup>And the glory which You gave Me I have given them, that they may be one just as We are one: <sup>23</sup>I in them, and You in Me; that they may be made perfect in one, and that the world may know that You have sent Me, and have loved them as You have loved Me."

Paul suffered for it as a prisoner of the Lord. He identifies himself as such for the sake of the truth; that the church is made up of Jews, Gentiles, slaves, and free men.

### A. Called into Unity

### Romans 8:30

Moreover whom He predestined, these He also called; whom He called, these He also justified; and whom He justified, these He also glorified.

### 2 Timothy 1:9

Who has saved us and called us with a holy calling, not according to our works, but according to His own purpose and grace which was given to us in Christ Jesus before time began,

A godly conduct should match this calling.

### **B. Practice Unity**

Walking implies a continuous practice. Many just took some steps, but the Bible urges us to walk worthy of our calling. If you look closely on the words like lowliness (humility), gentleness, longsuffering (patience), bearing (tolerance), and love, these qualities cannot be applied when others treat you well. You only need patience and tolerance when someone is irritating you or being difficult to get along with. While it is easier just to avoid such difficult people, Paul's appeal that we practice these qualities implies that we are seeking to work through relational differences.

### Galatians 5:22-26

<sup>22</sup>But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, <sup>23</sup>gentleness, self-control. Against such there is no law. <sup>24</sup>And those who are Christ's have crucified the flesh with its passions and desires. <sup>25</sup>If we live in the Spirit, let us also walk in the Spirit. <sup>26</sup>Let us not become conceited, provoking one another, envying one another.

### C. Preserve Unity

Diligence implies a deliberate effort. It suggests that we are not to allow disunity (division) to flourish.

### **Romans 14:19**

Therefore let us pursue the things

which make for peace and the things by which one may edify another.

Peace is the quality that binds us all together.

### Matthew 5:9

Blessed are the peacemakers, For they shall be called sons of God.

Jesus Christ is our peace. Because He is the Lord of our lives, we will enjoy peace between the body.

#### Conclusion

When your feelings are hurt or you hurt someone else's feelings, remember that true children of God are called peacemakers.
