7In Him we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of His grace swhich He made to abound toward us in all wisdom and prudence, shaving made known to us the mystery of His will, according to His good pleasure which He purposed in Himself, so that in the dispensation of the fullness of the times He might gather together in one all things in Christ, both which are in heaven and which are on earth—in Him.

The Bible tells us that we are born sinners and that we continue to sin because we follow or conform to the course of the world in rebellion to God. Sinners love to seek companions and co-sinners to share in their lifestyle, and death is the result of sin.

A. Only in Christ we have redemption.

We are enslaved to sin and had no power to free ourselves.

Jesus Christ paid the price to free us from the penalty and power of sin and death. Jesus Christ is our redeemer.

Redemption means to be released from bondage or debt by paying in full. There is no partial redemption or monthly arrangement.

When you receive and believe Jesus Christ, you are now redeemed.

Death is certain to those who sin. But the blood of Jesus redeemed us.

Hebrews 9:22

And according to the law almost all things are purified with blood, and without shedding of blood there is no remission.

Romans 3:24-25

²⁴Being justified freely by His grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus, ²⁵whom God set forth as a propitiation by His blood, through faith, to demonstrate His righteousness, because in His forbearance God had passed over the sins that were previously committed.

Trespasses may be synonymous with "sins", but their distinction

indicates individual acts of sin, not sin in general.

The world views Christians as sinless or perfect. But in truth, any believer in Jesus cannot claim that he does not sin anymore. That is why Jesus sent to us His Spirit (Holy Spirit) to convict us and to lead us to repentance and confession.

1 John 1:8-10

⁸If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us. ⁹If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness. ¹⁰If we say that we have not sinned, we make Him a liar, and His word is not in us.

Remember that God does not base our salvation on a sinless life but rather on the blood of Jesus, so work out your salvation with fear and trembling.

Philippians 2:12-13

¹²Therefore, my beloved, as you have always obeyed, not as in my presence only, but now much more in my absence, work out your own salvation with fear and trembling; ¹³for it is God who works in you both to will and to do for His good pleasure.

Be diligent to add to your faith...

2 Peter 1:5-9

⁵But also for this very reason, giving all diligence, add to your faith virtue, to virtue knowledge, 6to knowledge self-control, to self-control perseverance, perseverance godliness. 7to godliness brotherly kindness, and to brotherly kindness love. 8For if these things are yours and abound, you will be neither barren nor unfruitful in the knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ. 9For he who lacks these things is shortsighted, even to blindness, and has forgotten that he was cleansed from his old sins.

Conclusion

Many Christians misunderstood God's provision for forgiveness. They thought that since God's word assures them of forgiveness when they confess their sins, they can continue to sin.


Romans 6:1-2
