Introduction Hebrews 10:19-21

¹⁹Therefore, brethren, having boldness to enter the Holiest by the blood of Jesus, ²⁰by a new and living way which He consecrated for us, through the veil, that is, His flesh, ²¹and having a High Priest over the house of God.

We know that only the priests could enter the Holy place and only the high priest can enter the Holy of Holies once a year. All other worshippers can only worship from afar. Once every year when the high priest enters the Holy of Holies, he is going into the very presence of God represented by the Ark of the Covenant. If the high priest was found to have sinned, he immediately dies before the presence of God. And since nobody can retrieve the body, they devised a rope and wrapped it around the waist of the high priest that should he die, he would be pulled out by the rope.

works or merit but "by the blood
of Jesus." Jesus is our great High
Priest who rules over the house of
God. We are the house of God.



B. Let us hold fast the confession of our hope without wavering.

"Hope" refers to the future salvation. "Confession" refers to the public confession of faith in Jesus. It is comparable to a wedding ceremony, where both husband and wife pledge their love to one another publicly. "Hold fast"

implies that there are dangers or difficulties ahead.

Many will hinder you from your love to God. You may be tempted, but always remember your pledge.

James 4:7

Therefore submit to God. Resist the devil and he will flee from you.

C. Let us consider how to stimulate one another to love and to do good deeds.

"Consider" means that we should give some thought to "stir up" means to provoke, to incite, and to activate.

Christian love is not automatic. It requires thought and effort.

Let us give some thought and

effort to love and to do good works to one another.
