Romans 8:1 (NKJV)

There is therefore now no condemnation to those who are in Christ Jesus, who do not walk according to the flesh, but according to the Spirit.

Introduction

What does it mean for a person to be in Christ?

When a person believes in Christ:

Romans 8:28-30, 35-39

²⁸And we know that all things work together for good to those who love God, to those who are the called according to His purpose.

²⁹For whom He foreknew, He also predestined to be conformed to the image of His Son, that He might be the firstborn among many brethren. ³⁰Moreover whom He predestined, these He also called; whom He called, these He also justified; and whom He justified, these He also glorified.

³¹Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? Shall tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword? ³²As it is written: "For Your sake we are killed all day long; We are accounted as sheep for the slaughter." ³³Yet in all these things we are more than conquerors through Him who loved us. ³⁴For I am persuaded that neither death nor life, nor angels nor principalities nor powers, nor things present nor

things to come, ³⁵nor height nor depth, nor any other created thing, shall be able to separate us from the love of God which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.

- **He is identified with Christ.**

- **He is counted and considered to be in Christ.**

- **He is reckoned and credited as in Christ.**

- **He is in union with Christ and therefore he is no longer condemned and the curse of sin is broken.**

- **It means that a believer can now walk and live in Christ day by day.**

- **He no longer walks in the flesh but after the Spirit.**

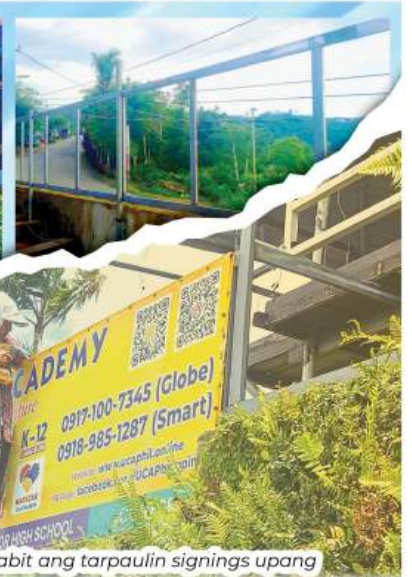

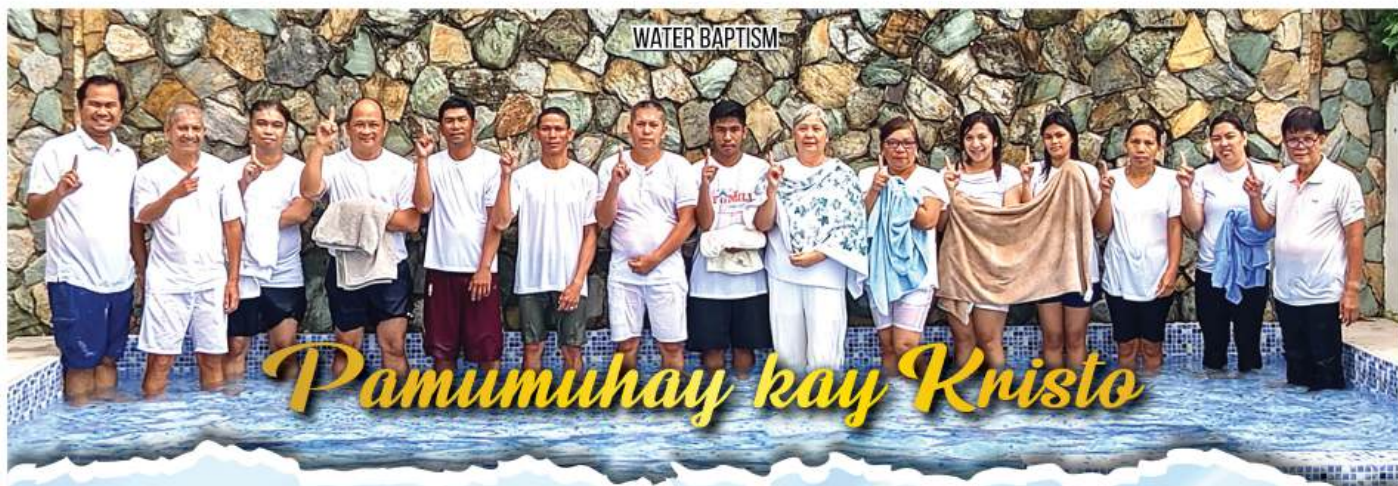


PAGKAKABIT NG PROMOTIONAL SIGN

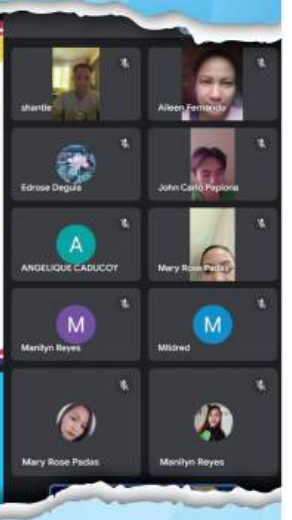
