Introduction

After being saved by God, what shall believers do?

• After being saved by God, believers should understand deeply that they are **created** and **prepared to do good works**.

Ephesians 2:8-10

⁸For by grace you have been saved through faith, and that not of yourselves; it is the gift of God, ⁹not of works, lest anyone should boast.

¹⁰For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand that we should walk in them.

• A true believer of Christ is a workman in a God-called church.

How do you get approval on what you do as a workman?

1. Be diligent.

2 Timothy 2:3-6

³You therefore must endure hardship as a good soldier of Jesus Christ. ⁴No one engaged in warfare entangles himself with the affairs of this life, that he may please him who enlisted him as a soldier. ⁵And also if anyone competes in athletics, he is not crowned unless he competes according to the rules. ⁶The hardworking farmer must be first to partake of the crops.

a. Like a soldier – a workman enduring hardship, pleasing who enlisted him as a soldier

b. Like an athlete – a workman competing according to the rules until he gets the crown

c. Like a farmer – a workman hardworking until he reaps the crops

2. Present yourself approved to God.

a. A workman should present his body as a living sacrifice to God.

Romans 12:1

I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that you present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable to God, which is your reasonable service.

b. A workman's goal should not present himself approved to people, but to God.

Colossians 3:22-24

²²Bondservants, obey in all things your masters according to the flesh, not with eyeservice, as men-pleasers, but in sincerity of heart, fearing God. ²³And whatever you do, do it heartily, as to the Lord and not to men, ²⁴knowing that from the Lord you will receive the reward of the inheritance; for you serve the Lord Christ.

c. A workman's goal should not worry so much about presenting other people approved to God, but his first concern should be to present himself approved to God.

1 Corinthians 9:27

But I discipline my body and bring it into subjection, lest, when I have preached to others, I myself should become disqualified.

3. A worker who does not need to be ashamed

a. Each workman will be examined at the judgment seat of Christ.

2 Corinthians 5:10

For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ, that each one may receive the things done in the body, according to what he has done, whether good or bad.

b. A workman will be tested by trial, and should stand the test.

1 Corinthians 3:12-15

¹²Now if anyone builds on this foundation with gold, silver, precious stones, wood, hay, straw, ¹³each one's work will become clear; for the Day will declare it, because it will be revealed by fire; and the fire will test each one's work, of what sort it is. ¹⁴If anyone's work which he has built on it endures, he will receive a reward. ¹⁵If anyone's work is burned, he will suffer loss; but he himself will be saved, yet so as through fire.

c. A workman should work diligently for the Lord, so he will not be ashamed when his work is examined.

Matthew 7:21-23

²¹“Not everyone who says to Me, ‘Lord, Lord,’ shall enter the kingdom of heaven, but he who does the will of My Father in heaven. ²²Many will say to Me in that day, ‘Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in Your name, cast out demons in Your name, and done many wonders

in Your name?’ ²³And then I will declare to them, ‘I never knew you; depart from Me, you who practice lawlessness!’

4. Rightly dividing the Word of Truth

a. A workman should rightly handle the Word of God, as one would rightly handle a sword.

b. A workman should cut a straight line on the Word of God, properly presenting the essential doctrines: to know what it said and didn't say, and how it was to be understood and how it was not to be understood.

c. A workman should properly dissect and arrange the Word of God, as a priest would dissect and arrange an animal for sacrifice: the word of truth is for pricking men in the heart and killing their sins.

d. A workman should allot to each their portion, as someone distributing food at a table: must understand that Biblical truth is not just an issue left up to everyone's interpretation.

²⁰But in a great house there are not only vessels of gold and silver, but also of wood and clay, some for honor and some for dishonor.

²¹Therefore if anyone cleanses himself from the latter, he will be a vessel for honor, sanctified and useful for the Master, prepared for every good work.
