John 21:15-17 (NKJV)

15So when they had eaten breakfast, Jesus said to Simon Peter, "Simon, son of Jonah, do vou love Me more than these?" He said to Him. "Yes. Lord; You know that I love You." He said to him, "Feed My lambs." 16He said to him again a second time, "Simon, son of Jonah, do you love Me?" He said to Him, "Yes, Lord; You know that I love You." He said to him, "Tend My sheep," 17He said to him the third time, "Simon, son of Jonah, do you love Me?" Peter was grieved because He said to him the third time, "Do you love Me?" And he said to Him, "Lord, You know all things; You know that I love You." Jesus said to him, "Feed My sheep.

Introduction

Many people served because they want to help advance Christ's kingdom on Earth. Some serve the Lord because they love studying theology and teaching the Bible accurately. Some serve because they genuinely want to help people with their problems. Some serve because they get a sense of satisfaction from serving. Some serve the Lord because it makes them feel important when they help people, and those people sing their praises. Some serve because they like being the center of attention. Some enjoy the power or the feeling of importance that comes from being in leadership. And some are in the ministry because they get financial support from it.

These reasons may sound noble but in itself is an inadequate reason for serving Christ.

What is your motivation for serving?

The two great commandments: love God and love others

If we love God because of His love and grace toward us, we will serve Him by loving others. So, loving Jesus, the eternal Son of God, who gave Himself on the cross to rescue us from God's judgment, is the essential motive for serving Him.

When your motive is not centered in loving God because He has forgiven all our sins, you will burn out or blow out in your service for the Lord.

1 Corinthians 13:1-3

¹Though I speak with the tongues of men and of angels, but have not love, I have become sounding brass or a clanging cymbal. 2And though I have the gift of prophecy, and understand all mysteries and all knowledge, and though I have all faith, so that I could remove mountains, but have not love, I am nothing. 3And though I bestow all my goods to feed the poor, and though I give my body to be burned, but have not love, it profits me nothing.

A. Loving Jesus is the center of our relationship.



1 Peter 5:1-3

'The elders who are among you I exhort, I who am a fellow elder and a witness of the sufferings of Christ, and also a partaker of the glory that will be revealed: 'Shepherd the flock

of God which is among you, serving as overseers, not by compulsion but willingly, not for dishonest gain but eagerly; ³nor as being lords over those entrusted to you, but being examples to the flock;

Shepherding the Lord's flock is primarily the job of the elders in each local church.

Acts 20:28

Therefore take heed to yourselves and to all the flock, among which the Holy Spirit has made you overseers, to shepherd the church of God which He purchased with His own blood.

A man should not be appointed as an elder before he begins to

shepherd the flock. Rather, he should be engaged already in shepherding the flock, and then the church recognizes that the Holy Spirit has appointed him as an elder.

Three times Jesus refers to the church as His: "My lambs, My sheep, My sheep." They don't belong to any pastor, but to the Lord. And since they belong to the Lord, who bought them with His own blood, we should be diligent to care for each one and love each one because each one is precious to Jesus.

Conclusion

Let us love God (Father, Jesus, Holy Spirit) first before tending His sheep.
