



What is Repentance?

Luke 24:44-47 (NKJV)

44Then He said to them, "These are the words which I spoke to you while I was still with you, that all things must be fulfilled which were written in the Law of Moses and the Prophets and the Psalms concerning Me." 45And He opened their understanding, that they might comprehend the Scriptures. ⁴⁶Then He said to them, "Thus it is written, and thus it was necessary for the Christ to suffer and to rise from the dead the third day, 47 and that repentance and remission of sins should be preached in His name to all nations, beginning at Jerusalem.

Introduction

The root meaning of the word repentance

- It is a change of mind or purpose.
- It is a sincere and thorough change of the mind and disposition in regard to sin.
- It involves:
- · a change of view
- · a change of feeling
- · a change of purpose

Note

It contains three (3) elements:

- 1. The intellectual
- 2. The emotional
- 3. The voluntary

A. The intellectual element

- It involves a change of view with regard to sin (God and self).
- Sin is recognized not merely as a weakness, an unfortunate happening, or a mistake, but as a personal guilt.

Psalm 5:3

My voice You shall hear in the morning, O Lord; In the morning I will direct it to You, And I will look up. Sin is recognized to be a transgression against God.

B. The emotional element

- Repentance has often been defined as a Godly sorrow for sin.

2 Corinthians 7:9-10

°Now I rejoice, not that you were made sorry, but that your sorrow led to repentance. For you were made sorry in a godly manner, that you might suffer loss from us in nothing. ¹ºFor godly sorrow produces repentance leading to salvation, not to be regretted; but the sorrow of the world produces death.

- The publican who beat his breast Luke 18:13

And the tax collector, standing afar off, would not so much as raise his eyes to heaven, but beat his breast, saying, 'God, be merciful to me a sinner!'

C. The voluntary element

- It means an inward turning from sin and a wholehearted turning to Christ for forgiveness.
- The word repentance means "to turn."
- The story of the prodigal son

Luke 15:18

I will arise and go to my father, and will say to him, "Father, I have sinned against heaven and before you,

Luke 15:20

"And he arose and came to his father. But when he was still a great way off, his father saw him and had compassion, and ran and fell on his neck and kissed him.

Note

As repentance touches the will, it will result in:

1. Confessing Sin

Psalm 38:18

For I will declare my iniquity; I will be in anguish over my sin.

Luke 15:21

And the son said to him, 'Father, I have sinned against heaven and in your sight, and am no longer worthy to be called your son.'

2. Forsaking Sin

Proverbs 28:13

He who covers his sins will not prosper, But whoever confesses and forsakes them will have mercy.

Isaiah 55:7

Let the wicked forsake his way, And the unrighteous man his thoughts; Let him return to the Lord, And He will have mercy on him; And to our God, For He will abundantly pardon.

3. Turning to God


