

Healing and Deliverance

Mark 16:15-18 (NKJV)

¹⁵And He said to them, "Go into all the world and preach the gospel to every creature. ¹⁶He who believes and is baptized will be saved; but he who does not believe will be condemned. ¹⁷And these signs will follow those who believe: In My name they will cast out demons; they will speak with new tongues; ¹⁸they will take up serpents; and if they drink anything deadly, it will by no means hurt them; they will lay hands on the sick, and they will recover."

Background

• **Healing and Deliverance** – "Exercising and Executing God-given Gifts"

- Most believers do not understand:
 - who they are in Christ – children of God
 - what they have – authority as children of God
 - what they need to do – do it according to the will of God

As believers of Christ, we can do the following signs "In Jesus' name."

A. Casting out Demons

1. Demon-possessed – an unbeliever taken control strongly by the devil; his body was owned by the devil

Matthew 8:16 (NKJV)

When evening had come, they brought to Him many who were demon-possessed. And He cast out the spirits with a word, and healed all who were sick,

Matthew 9:32-33 (NKJV)

³²As they went out, behold, they brought to Him a man, mute and demon-possessed. ³³And when the demon was cast out, the mute spoke. And the multitudes marveled, saying, "It was never seen like this in Israel!"

Luke 8:27-31 (NKJV)

²⁷And when He stepped out on the land, there met Him a certain man from the city who had demons for a long time. And he wore no clothes, nor did he live in a house but in the tombs. ²⁸When he saw Jesus, he cried out, fell down before Him, and with a loud voice said, "What have I to do with You, Jesus, Son of the Most High God? I beg You, do not torment me!" ²⁹For He had commanded the unclean spirit to come out of the man. For it had often seized him, and he was kept under guard, bound with chains and shackles; and he broke the bonds and was driven by the demon into the wilderness. ³⁰Jesus asked him, saying, "What is your name?" And he said, "Legion," because many demons had entered him. ³¹And they begged Him that He would not command them to go out into the abyss.

2. Demonized – a believer who has been deceived by the devil and has started to be controlled by the devil

1 Samuel 18:10-11 (NKJV)

¹⁰And it happened on the next day that the distressing spirit from God came upon Saul, and he prophesied inside the house. So David played music with his hand, as at other times; but there was a spear in Saul's hand. ¹¹And Saul cast the spear, for he said, "I will pin David to the wall!" But David escaped his presence twice.

B. Healing the Sick

1. Sicknesses caused by natural factors

Matthew 15:29-31 (NKJV)

²⁹Jesus departed from there, skirted the Sea of Galilee, and went up on the mountain and sat down there. ³⁰Then great multitudes came to Him, having with them the lame, blind, mute, maimed, and many others; and they laid them

down at Jesus' feet, and He healed them. ³¹So the multitude marveled when they saw the mute speaking, the maimed made whole, the lame walking, and the blind seeing; and they glorified the God of Israel.

Mark 1:40-42 (NKJV)

⁴⁰Now a leper came to Him, imploring Him, kneeling down to Him and saying to Him, "If You are willing, You can make me clean." ⁴¹Then Jesus, moved with compassion, stretched out His hand and touched him, and said to him, "I am willing; be cleansed." ⁴²As soon as He had spoken, immediately the leprosy left him, and he was cleansed.

Acts 5:12-16 (NKJV)

¹²And through the hands of the apostles many signs and wonders were done among the people. And they were all with one accord in Solomon's Porch. ¹³Yet none of the rest dared join them, but the people esteemed them highly. ¹⁴And believers were increasingly added to the Lord, multitudes of both men and women, ¹⁵so that they brought the sick out into the streets and laid them on beds and couches, that at least the shadow of Peter passing by might fall on some of them.

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¹⁶Also a multitude gathered from the surrounding cities to Jerusalem, bringing sick people and those who were tormented by unclean spirits, and they were all healed.

2. Sicknesses caused by generational sins

Luke 13:10-13 (NKJV)

¹⁰Now He was teaching in one of the synagogues on the Sabbath. ¹¹And behold, there was a woman who had a spirit of infirmity eighteen years, and was bent over and could in no way raise herself up. ¹²But when Jesus saw her, He called her to Him and said to her, "Woman, you are loosed from your infirmity." ¹³And He laid His hands on her, and immediately she was made straight, and glorified God.

3. Sicknesses caused by self-inflicted sins

Matthew 9:1-2 (NKJV)

¹So He got into a boat, crossed over, and came to His own city. ²Then behold, they brought to Him a paralytic lying on a bed. When Jesus saw their faith, He said to the paralytic, "Son, be of good cheer; your sins are forgiven you."

C. Deliverance

1. Meaning:

- a. The act of rescuing someone
- b. To save from the penalty, power, and ultimately the presence of sin and eternal death

2. Stronghold of the enemies in one's life

a. Idolatries

Exodus 20:1-5 (NKJV)

¹And God spoke all these words, saying:

²"I am the Lord your God, who brought you out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of bondage. ³"You shall have no other gods before Me. ⁴"You shall not make for yourself a carved image—any likeness of anything that is in heaven above, or that is in the earth beneath, or that is in the water under the earth; ⁵you shall not bow down to them nor serve them. For I, the Lord your God, am a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children to the third and fourth generations of those who hate Me,

b. Curses

Deuteronomy 18:10-12 (NKJV)

¹⁰There shall not be found among you anyone who makes his son or his daughter pass through the fire, or one who practices witchcraft, or a soothsayer, or one who interprets omens, or a sorcerer, ¹¹or one who conjures spells, or a medium, or a spiritist, or one who calls up the dead.

¹²For all who do these things are an abomination to the Lord, and because of these abominations the Lord your God drives them out from before you.

c. Unforgiveness

Matthew 6:14-15 (NKJV)

¹⁴"For if you forgive men their trespasses, your heavenly Father will also forgive you. ¹⁵But if you do not forgive men their trespasses, neither will your Father forgive your trespasses.

d. Lust and Sexual Immorality

1 Corinthians 6:18-20 (NKJV)

¹⁸Flee sexual immorality. Every sin that a man does is outside the body, but he who commits sexual immorality sins against his own body. ¹⁹Or do you not know that your body is the temple of the Holy Spirit who is in you, whom you have from God, and you are not your

own? ²⁰For you were bought at a price; therefore glorify God in your body and in your spirit, which are God's.

e. Repeated Sins

1 John 3:4-9 (NASB)

⁴Whoever commits sin also commits lawlessness, and sin is lawlessness. ⁵And you know that He was manifested to take away our sins, and in Him there is no sin. ⁶Whoever abides in Him does not sin. Whoever sins has neither seen Him nor known Him. ⁷Little children, let no one deceive you. He who practices righteousness is righteous, just as He is righteous. ⁸He who sins is of the devil, for the devil has sinned from the beginning. For this purpose the Son of God was manifested, that He might destroy the works of the devil. ⁹Whoever has been born of God does not sin, for His seed remains in him; and he cannot sin, because he has been born of God.

3. Self-deliverance

- a. Have the Holy Spirit determine the sins or evil spirits.
- b. Release forgiveness to others.
- c. Ask forgiveness from God.
- d. Cast out the evil spirits.

D. Spiritual Warfare

1. The Battle: Kingdom of Darkness vs Kingdom of Light

Ephesians 6:10-12 (NKJV)

¹⁰Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord and in the power of His might. ¹¹Put on the whole armor of God, that you may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil. ¹²For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this age, against spiritual hosts of wickedness in the heavenly places.

2. The Armor of God

Ephesians 6:13-20 (NKJV)

¹³Therefore take up the whole armor of God, that you may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand. ¹⁴Stand therefore, having girded your waist with truth, having put on the breastplate of righteousness, ¹⁵and having shod your feet with the preparation of the gospel of peace; ¹⁶above all, taking the shield of faith with which you will be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked one. ¹⁷And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God; ¹⁸praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, being watchful to this end with all perseverance and supplication for all the saints—¹⁹and for me, that utterance may be given to me, that I may open my mouth boldly to make known the mystery of the gospel, ²⁰for which I am an ambassador in chains; that in it I may speak boldly, as I ought to speak.

a. Defensive Armors

- a.1. Belt of truth (v. 14)
- a.2. Breastplate of righteousness (v. 14)
- a.3. Boots fitted with the gospel of peace (v. 15)
- a.4. Shield of faith (v. 16)
- a.5. Helmet of salvation (v. 17)

b. Offensive Weapons

- b.1. Sword of the Spirit (v. 17) - Word of God
- b.2. Prayer (v. 18)
- b.3. Boldness to share (v. 19-20)
