

The Double Predestination

Romans 9:10-13 (NKJV)

¹⁰And not only this, but when Rebecca also had conceived by one man, even by our father Isaac ¹¹(for the children not yet being born, nor having done any good or evil, that the purpose of God according to election might stand, not of works but of Him who calls), ¹²it was said to her, "The older shall serve the younger." ¹³As it is written, "Jacob I have loved, but Esau I have hated."

Introduction

Historically, the "double predestination" teaches God's sovereign predestinating work. It has two aspects or sides of it.

Election – chosen person Reprobation – depraved person

Scoundrel - disreputable person or a rascal

Rascal – unprincipled or dishonest person or a rogue

Rogue - corrupt or dishonest

Note

Double predestination initially rejects universalism. It teaches that God, in His sovereign grace, saved His elect. And those who are not numbered on the elect are numbered among the reprobate, those who are not saved.

If you believed in the Divine Election and believe in predestination, unless you are a universalist, you have to believe in double predestination. Not everybody is elected.

The non-elect is distinguished from the elect, which historically has been called a symmetrical view of election, or sometimes called equal ultimacy.

In the case of the elect, God intervened in their lives and creates faith in their hearts through the "power of regeneration" activated by God the Holy Spirit.

In the case of the reprobate, God also intervenes in their lives to harden their hearts and to create as it were fresh evil in their souls to make sure they do not repent and come to faith.

On the other hand, the view of equal ultimacy is called a positive-

positive view, where God positively intervenes in the lives of the elect and God also positively intervenes in the lives of the reprobate.

Note

In abhorrent or orthodox Calvinism, that is not what reform theology teaches in terms of double predestination. Rather, predestination is asymmetrical. It is a positive-negative view. God positively intervenes in the life of the elect and gives them mercy they don't deserve, and leaves the rest of corrupt mankind to their own devices.

He does not coerce them to unbelief:

- So that one group gets grace.
- The other group gets justice.
 Nobody receives injustice.

Note

God chooses to give grace to some and chooses not to give grace to others.

When God speaks to you,

He speaks through your heart.

From your heart, it will come to your mind.

God convicts the hearts

and it is responsible for managing

the mind.
