## **Introduction**

Who do you turn to when you are under pressure or stressed?

Many of these stresses or pressures are the result of your own doing. When it piles up, you will begin to struggle just to cope with it and when it is too much, depression will come.

Our modern culture gives us too many options to turn to when under stress or experiencing pressures of life. Some take sessions of stress management while others attend classes on meditation practices. Even Christians agree that these methods helped them to cope with stress and some even turned to medications. But there are also few who turn to God and take refuge in Him.

God did not promise us a life without stress or pressure. God promised us that He will never leave us nor forsake us.

## **Deuteronomy 31:8**

And the Lord, He is the One who goes before you. He will be with you, He will not leave you nor forsake you; do not fear nor be dismayed.

The remedy for stress is to trust in the sovereign, personal Lord.

**A. Stress is a fact of life, even for the godly.**

Many believers have this notion that if we follow and obey the Lord, He will protect us from difficult trials. But the Bible repeatedly shows that it is often because you follow the Lord that you encounter various trials. If you blend in with the world, they don't bother you. But the fact that you follow Christ makes you the special target.

## **John 15:18-19**

<sup>18</sup>If the world hates you, you know that it hated Me before it hated you. <sup>19</sup>If you were of the world, the world would love its own. Yet because you are not of the world, but I chose you out of the world, therefore the world hates you.

## **1. In stress, we should not trust in ourselves but in God.**

## **2 Corinthians 1:8-11**

<sup>8</sup>For we do not want you to be ignorant, brethren, of our trouble which came to us in Asia: that we were burdened beyond measure, above strength, so that we despaired even of life. <sup>9</sup>Yes, we had the sentence of death in ourselves, that we should not trust in ourselves but in God who raises the dead, <sup>10</sup>who delivered us from so great a death, and does deliver us; in whom we trust that He will still deliver us, <sup>11</sup>you also helping together in prayer for us, that thanks may be given by many persons on our behalf for the gift granted to us through many.

## **2. Be prepared for stress.**

When there's a big storm coming, we prepare for the worst. We stock food and water and charge all our phones, including our emergency lights. Some even prepare for

their generators, just in case of a blackout. We visualize these things in advance to anticipate and to minimize the damage that the big storm could bring.

Trusting God prepares us for the stress.

- v. 1 - You are righteous.
- v. 3 - You are my rock and my fortress.
- v. 4 - You are my strength.
- v. 5 - You have redeemed me.
- v. 7 - You have considered my trouble.
- v. 8 - You have set my feet in a wide place and many more.

Prepare yourself before the storm hits. Spend time alone with God and His Word, feeding your soul. Let His Word confront your life with sin that needs to be dealt with. Then you'll be ready for stressful times.

## **3. In stress, admit your sins and take refuge in God.**

## **Proverbs 28:13**

He who covers his sins will not prosper, But whoever confesses and forsakes them will have mercy.

## **Galatians 6:7-8**



"For he who sows to his flesh will of the flesh reap corruption, but he who sows to the Spirit will of the Spirit reap everlasting life.

In verse 9-10, David recognizes his own sin was behind the crisis he was in. God will forgive our sin if we confess and forsake it, but He doesn't necessarily remove the consequences. But even if our calamity is the direct result of our sin, we can still run to God for refuge and know that He will receive us!

We must never condone sin, but we must be careful not to condemn repentant sinners. Thank God that He is gracious and through the blood of Jesus forgives all our sin, or none of us could be here today! We need to encourage repentant sinners who are suffering those consequences, even then to take refuge in God's grace and love.

### 4. God is faithful and will not allow us to go through stress more than we can bear.

#### 1 Corinthians 10:13

No temptation has overtaken you except such as is common to man; but God is faithful, who will not allow you to be tempted beyond what you are able, but with the temptation will also make the way of escape, that you may be able to bear it.

### B. God is sovereign over our stress (our lives).

We must recognize and trust God's sovereignty over all things for all things to work in our favor.

#### Romans 8:28

And we know that all things work together for good to those who love God, to those who are the called according to His purpose.

Joseph being sold by his brothers to slavery opens the opportunity to become Egypt's second in command.

Many times, we fail to understand the plans and purpose of God in our lives. Because we wanted to be in-charge of our lives, we fail to recognize God's sovereignty over all things.

In verse 15, David affirms God's sovereignty over all when he said, "My times are in your hand."

#### Ephesians 1:11

In Him also we have obtained an inheritance, being predestined according to the purpose of Him who works all things according to the counsel of His will.

When a tragedy hits us, God was not asleep or on vacation. His sovereignty is a great comfort in a time of trial. We can know that He has designed our distressing situation to teach us more about what it means to take refuge in Him.

#### James 1:2-4

<sup>2</sup>My brethren, count it all joy when you fall into various trials, <sup>3</sup>knowing that the testing of your faith produces patience. <sup>4</sup>But let patience

have its perfect work, that you may be perfect and complete, lacking nothing.

#### Conclusion

We must actively trust God even if we cannot see ahead.

Verse 14 - But as for me, I trust in You, O Lord; I say, "You are my God."

#### 1 Peter 5:6-10

<sup>6</sup>Therefore humble yourselves under the mighty hand of God, that He may exalt you in due time, <sup>7</sup>casting all your care upon Him, for He cares for you. <sup>8</sup>Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil walks about like a roaring lion, seeking whom he may devour. <sup>9</sup>Resist him, steadfast in the faith, knowing that the same sufferings are experienced by your

brotherhood in the world. <sup>10</sup>But may the God of all grace, who called us to His eternal glory by Christ Jesus, after you have suffered a while, perfect, establish, strengthen, and settle you.

Even Jonah (in the big fish belly) recites Psalm 31:6a - I have hated those who regard useless idols; (Jonah 2:8)

Jesus final words recites Psalm 31:5a - Into Your hand I commit my spirit; (Luke 23:46)

Our trust in God should result in praises.
