Re-setting our Lives

Two Aspects:

1. Set your hearts on things above.

2. Set your minds not on earthly things.

Presenting our Bodies as a Living Sacrifice

Romans 12:1-2

¹ I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that you present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable to God, which is your reasonable service. ²And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God.

Two Things:

1. It should be holy.
2. It should be acceptable to God (which is our reasonable service to God).

Note

1. By not conforming to world system
2. By transforming through renewing of our mind

Challenge

So that we may be able to test and to prove God's purpose in our life

1. What is God's will (discover)
2. What is good (so to do)
3. What is pleasing (not our liking, but God's)
4. What is perfect will of God (acceptable, pleasing, perfect will of God)
